The 35 schools were ranked on the dimensions of English/language arts and mathematics proficiency rates and the three year slope (trend over the last three years). The school with largest percent proficient for 2010 was given a rank of 1, and the school with the smallest percent proficient was given a rank of 35 (*Ranking for 2010 % Proficient*). The school with the largest (improving) slope value was given a rank of 1 and the school with the smallest (regressing) slope value was given a rank of 35 (*Ranking for Three Year Slope*). An overall average ranking (*Average Ranking*) was created for each school by taking the average for the ranking for *Ranking for 2010 % Proficient* and *Ranking for Three Year Slope*. The lowest- achieving schools for this category were determined by taking the five schools with the largest scores (values) for the overall *Average Ranking* column. The five schools are listed above. Eligible schools could also be listed as lowest-achieving if the school had a graduation rate less than 60% for each of the last three years. There were no schools in this category that met the graduation rate criterion.

There were 19 eligible schools. The 19 schools were ranked on the dimensions of English/language arts and mathematics proficiency rates and the three year slope (trend over the last three years). The school with largest percent proficient for 2010 was given a rank of 1, and the school with the smallest percent proficient was given a rank of 19 (*Ranking for 2010 % Proficient*). The school with the largest (improving) slope value was given a rank of 1 and the school with the smallest (regressing) slope value was given a rank of 19 (*Ranking for Three Year Slope*). An overall average ranking (*Average Ranking*) was created for each school by taking the average for the ranking for *Ranking for 2010 % Proficient* and *Ranking for Three Year Slope*. The lowest- achieving schools for this category were determined by taking the five schools with the largest scores (values) for the overall *Average Ranking* column. The five schools are listed above. Eligible schools could also be listed as lowest-achieving if the school had a graduation rate less than 60% for each of the last three years.
