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2000 DSTP Executive Summary

The results from the first administration of the eighth and eleventh grade science and social studies portions of the Delaware Student Testing Program (DSTP) represent an important step in Delaware's efforts to educate all students to a higher level. These results are part of a long-term effort to gather data on our students' educational progress and to use the data to inform our decisions about instruction. Studied over time, the data will help identify trends and patterns that can be directly related to curriculum and instruction, giving districts and schools additional decision-making tools. Science and social studies data for grades 8 and 11 are summarized here. Results for grades 4 and 6 will be published in the winter.

The data reported in this state summary represent the first stage in providing information about student performance relative to the state's standards in science and social studies. This year's data are reported as raw scores; i.e., the number of points correct out of the total number of points possible for each reporting category. The mean raw scores only indicate averages—not success or failure in the subjects assessed. The averages do not represent the specific score point that each student has earned. Some students may have scored considerably higher or lower than the average. Following the second administration of the science and social studies tests, the raw scores will be converted into scale scores and performance levels that indicate the degree to which students are meeting state expectations in science and social studies. Like the writing portion of the DSTP, there are no national percentile rankings for the science and social studies tests because these tests have been developed by Delaware educators and are not administered nationally.

DSTP Science Test

The DSTP science test was administered for the first time in the spring of 2000 to Delaware students in grades 8 and 11. Elementary students took their first science test in the fall of 2000. The test for the K-3 cluster was administered at the beginning of the fourth grade, and the 4-5 cluster was administered at the beginning of sixth grade. The DSTP science test is designed to measure student progress toward the Delaware content standards in science.

Success on the DSTP science test requires students to demonstrate their knowledge of, understanding of, and capabilities in the content and skills articulated in the science content standards. The questions target student understanding of the big ideas in science such as structure/function relationships, energy-matter transformations, physical/chemical properties of materials, and prominent laws and theories such as evolution, plate tectonics, gravity, and conservations of matter.

Science standard one, The Nature and Application of Science and Technology, infuses all seven content standards and requires students to interpret or create charts, graphs, tables, and diagrams or other visual representations. Science standard one also requires students to design simple investigations, draw conclusions, identify variables, or make predictions based on data. In some instances students are asked to group, sort, and classify objects or organisms based on similarities or physical and chemical properties. In other instances students are asked to provide complete explanations in their constructed responses. One-word or vague responses do not qualify for full credit. Appropriate vocabulary, while desirable, is not essential provided that students show conceptual understanding in their written responses.

Every item on the DSTP science test is linked to the Delaware science content standards. The items have been written/edited by Delaware teachers and educators, have been field-tested within the state, and have been approved by both the Bias Review Committee and the Science Content Advisory Committee.

The science test consists of two item formats: short answer (constructed response) and multiple choice. The table to the right shows the approximate percentage of items by reporting category and proportionately reflects the content standards.

The test consists of a total of 32 multiple choice items which are scored on a scale point range of 0-1, and 18 constructed response items which are scored on a scale point range of 0-1-2.

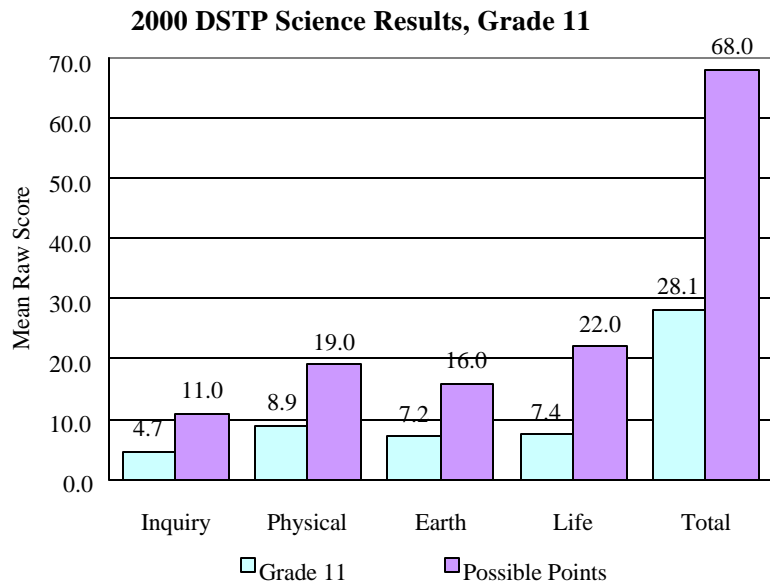
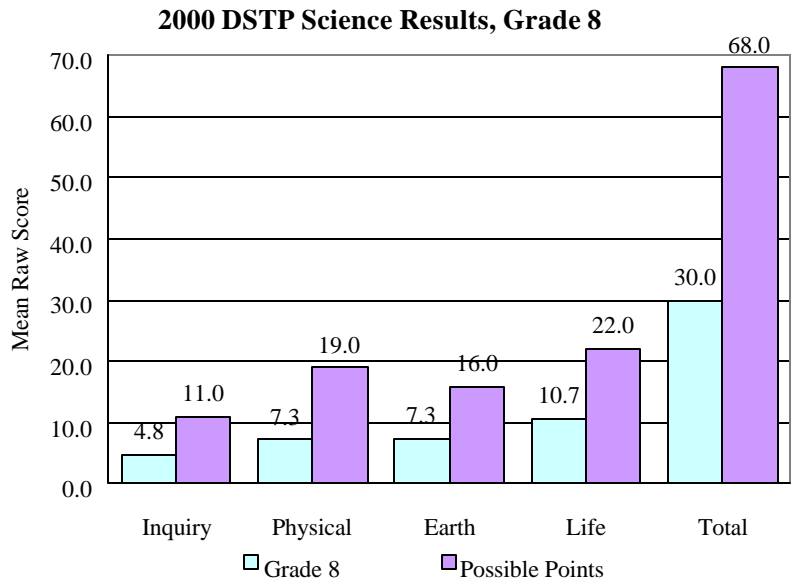

2000 Science Results, Grades 8 and 11

Following are the state-level results from the science portion of the DSTP administered to eighth and eleventh graders in Spring 2000. Additional details can be obtained from the appendices of this report and from the Department of Education web page at <http://www.doe.state.de.us/aab>.

The charts show the mean raw scores for eighth and eleventh grade students who took the science portion of the DSTP in the spring of 2000. Only valid aggregable scores of students enrolled in Delaware regular schools are included in group aggregations. There are no longitudinal data because this is the first live administration of the science test. The sub-scores for Inquiry, Physical, Earth, and Life Science show that on the average students across the state tended to earn less than half the number of points possible in each of the four reporting categories. Inquiry measures the nature of science and technology. Physical science measures both materials and their properties and energy and its effects. Earth science measures students' understanding of earth, space, and earth's dynamic systems. Life science includes life processes, diversity, continuity of living things, and ecology.



DSTP Social Studies Test

The DSTP social studies test was administered for the first time in the spring of 2000 to Delaware students in grades 8 and 11. Elementary students took their first social studies test in the fall of 2000. The test for the K-3 cluster was administered at the beginning of the fourth grade, and the 4-5 cluster was administered at the beginning of sixth grade. The DSTP social studies test measures students' ability to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of key social studies concepts identified in the Delaware social studies content standards. The concepts are in the four core areas of civics, economics, geography, and history.

DSTP social studies items are designed to measure how well a student:

- understands the concept identified in the content standard;
- applies knowledge and understanding using the skill or process identified in the standard;
- connects knowledge to the concept and process in order to explain support, or justify the response.

Every item on the DSTP social studies test is linked to the Delaware social studies content standards. The items have been written/edited by Delaware teachers and educators, have been field-tested within the state, and have been approved by both the Bias Review Committee and the Social Studies Content Advisory Committee.

The social studies test includes 28 multiple choice items and 20 short answer (constructed response) items. The short answer items are open-ended and require the student to write a valid response, including an example or evidence to further explain the answer. These items represent 59% of the total points on the test. Both the multiple choice and the short answer items present students with a context for the application of a concept from the social studies content standards. A successful response to an item requires that a student think through the information presented, apply a concept, and then respond to the question. Information might be presented in graphs, maps, charts, diary entries, drawings, surveys, newspaper headlines and other formats. The multiple choice items are scored at one point for each correct response, and the short answer items are scored on a 0-1-2 scale with a scoring rubric for each item.

The social studies concepts for each content area are identified for each grade cluster (K-3, 4-5, 6-8, and 9-12) in the Delaware Content Standards for Social Studies. The items that measure each of these concepts provide the opportunity for students to demonstrate understanding of that concept as identified for that grade cluster in the standards.

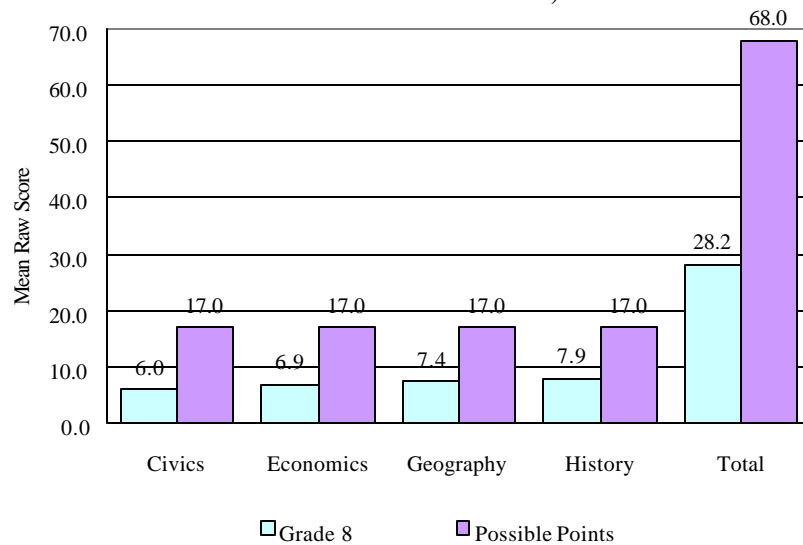
2000 Social Studies Results, Grades 8 and 11

Following are the state-level results from the 2000 social studies portion of the DSTP administered to eighth and eleventh graders in Spring 2000. Additional details can be obtained from the appendices of this report.

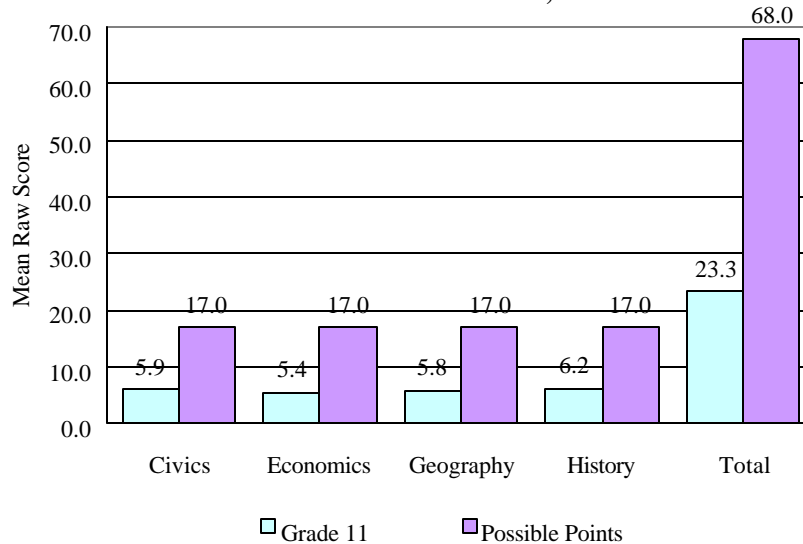
The charts show the raw scores for eighth and eleventh grade students who took the social studies portion of the DSTP in the spring of 2000. Only valid aggregable scores of students enrolled in Delaware regular schools are included in group aggregations. There are no longitudinal data because this is the first live administration of the social studies test. The DSTP social studies test assesses students' knowledge and understanding of the content, concepts, and processes in the core areas of civics, economics, geography, and history. The sub-scores show that on the average students across the state tended to earn less than half the number of points possible in each of the four reporting categories.

The social studies portion of the DSTP measures each core area equally (17 points per area). Each content area contains seven multiple choice items and five short answer items. Multiple choice items count one point each, and short answer items count a maximum of two points each.

Student Participation

A goal of the DSTP is to have as many as possible of Delaware's public school students at each state test grade participate. To achieve this goal, participation guidelines for students with disabilities and limited English proficient (LEP) students have been established by the DOE with input from local educators and experts in both fields. The guidelines are in accordance with Federal regulations governing the inclusion of these students in state testing programs.

Accommodations and Exemptions

Special education students take the DSTP under regular conditions, test with accommodations, or participate in the Delaware Alternate Portfolio Assessment (DAPA). LEP students are required to take the DSTP under regular conditions, test with accommodations, or be officially exempted from all or part of the test. While most accommodations allow us to include a student's score with the general population of students, a few require that we exclude the score.

Reporting Scores of Students with Accommodations

Scores of students testing with accommodations that do not interfere with the comparability of their scores will have their scores included with those of students testing under regular conditions in school, district, and state results. If the accommodations interfere with comparability, the scores are not included in the school, district, and state results. However, individual score reports are produced for all students who test.

School personnel such as special education planning teams, LEP program instructors, teachers, and school administrators participate in and document the decisions about exemptions and accommodations.

Absences, Suspensions, and Expulsions

Students are considered absent for the DSTP only if they are absent or suspended for the entire test week and the make-up week that follows. Students who are expelled from school do not take the DSTP within that school but take the DSTP if they are enrolled in an alternative program. Students in alternative programs are required to take the DSTP.

Valid Scores

To receive a valid score on the science portion of the DSTP, a student must attempt at least one item on the science test. Likewise, to receive a valid score on the social studies portion, a student must attempt at least one social studies item.

Disaggregation of Data

To determine how well educators are meeting the needs of all learners, the DSTP data are disaggregated by gender, race/ethnicity, free/reduced price meal eligibility, Title I, disability, English proficiency, and migrant status. This gives a picture of how various subpopulations are doing in relation to the majority. Educational strategies that may address the needs and learning styles of majority students and consequently raise performance overall may not meet the needs of certain subgroups of students, resulting in a performance gap. Data disaggregation reveals whether educators are actually meeting the needs of all learners or just those students whose learning styles and culture respond to a particular instructional style. Disaggregation is an important step in the process of collecting and analyzing data to accurately determine student needs and the causal factors behind those needs. Instructional and programmatic strategies to address the identified needs can then be selected and implemented by educators.

Each content area has four reporting categories. The possible points for the category appear at the top of each table. There are no percentile ranks for either science or social studies.

Mean: Indicates the mean (“average”) raw score. A raw score is the number of points correct out of the total possible points.

SD: Indicates the standard deviation for the mean raw score.

School Results

The following tables contain the Spring 2000 DSTP science and social studies results for grades 8 and 11 at the school level. Only valid aggregable scores of students enrolled in Delaware regular schools are included in the state, district, and school aggregations. Fourth and sixth grade data will be published following the fall administration. Within each content area, regular schools are arranged by district, followed by charter schools. Special schools are listed separately beginning on page 33.

Mean raw scores are given for each reporting category and for the total test. The mean raw score tells the average number of points the tested students in a school answered correctly out of the total possible points for the category. Each content area has four reporting categories. The possible points for each category appear at the top of the table. There are no percentile ranks for either science or social studies.

For certain schools, there is a discrepancy between the data reported in this document and the data published in the school reports sent to the schools by Harcourt. This occurred because there were duplicate student records in the preliminary data. In all cases where differences occur, the data in the state summary report are the correct numbers.

Appendix C: Disaggregations

The following tables contain the Spring 2000 DSTP science and social studies disaggregated data for grades 8 and 11 at the state and district levels. Only valid aggregable scores of students enrolled in Delaware regular schools are included in the state, district, and school aggregations. Fourth and sixth grade data will be published following the fall administration of those tests. Results are not published unless the number of students contributing to a score (N) is at least 15. Mean raw scores are given for each reporting category and for the total test. The mean raw score tells the average number of points the tested students in a school answered correctly out of the total possible points for the reporting category. Each content area has four reporting categories. The possible points for each category appear at the top of the table. There are no percentile ranks for either science or social studies.

For certain schools, there is a discrepancy between the data reported in this document and the data published in the school reports sent to the schools by Harcourt. This occurred because there were duplicate student records in the preliminary data. In all cases where differences occur, the data in the state summary report are the correct numbers.

The following legend can be used to understand what each column of figures contains.

- N: Indicates the number of students that contributed to the mean raw score.
- Mean: Indicates the mean (“average”) raw score. A raw score is the number of points correct out of the total possible points.
- SD: Indicates the standard deviation for the mean raw score.
