Pre-requisite formal training:

1. Verified successful completion of at least 576 hours of specific Graphic & Printing Equipment Operator formal training above the high school level, OR
2. A confirmed 70% or above score on each of the Written and Performance Assessments of the National Occupational Competency Testing Institute's (NOCTI) Graphic Imaging Technology (0137) Experienced Worker (Teacher) Assessments [www.nocti.org](http://www.nocti.org).

Certification requirements:

1. PrintED Approved Instructor Certification [www.gaerf.org](http://www.gaerf.org). Application for this certification is confirmed via a letter from GAERF PrintEd.

For Delaware STS Teacher Certification, verified successful completion of 576 hours of specific Graphic & Printing Equipment Operator formal training above the high school level is equal to six Career-Related credits. For Delaware STS Teacher Certification, a letter confirming the candidate as an Approved PrintED Instructor is equal to three Career-Related credits. For Delaware STS Teacher Certification, a confirmed 70% or above score on each of the Written and Performance Assessments of the National Occupational Competency Testing Institute's (NOCTI) Graphic Imaging Technology (0137) Experienced Worker (Teacher) Assessment is equal to nine Career-Related credits.
