Pre-requisite Experience:

1. Prospective teachers must have a minimum of six years of Culinary/Kitchen work experience that includes at least 2 years working in a supervisory capacity. Up to two years of Pastry/Baking experience can be used to count toward this six-year minimum.

Pre-requisite Requirements:

1. Associate's or Bachelor's Degree in Culinary Arts, OR
2. A confirmed 70% or above score on each of the Written and Performance Assessments of the National Occupational Competency Testing Institute's (NOCTI) Quantity Food Preparation (0117) Experienced Worker (Teacher) Assessments www.nocti.org.

For Delaware STS Teacher Certification, a confirmed 70% or above score on each of the Written and Performance Assessments of the National Occupational Competency Testing Institute's (NOCTI) Quantity Food Preparation (0117) Experienced Worker (Teacher) Assessments is equal to nine Career-Related credits.
