Data Categories	Instructions
STATE STUDENT IDENTIFICATION NUMBER	The Department of Education will provide the student identification number. If you are a school district, you can assign the student a number using DELSIS and note in the accompanying space. Then return to the Department.
LAST NAME	Complete last name.
FIRST NAME	Complete first name.
MIDDLE NAME	Complete middle name.
DATE OF BIRTH (MM/DD/YYYY)	Provide birth date using numbers for month. For example, January would be 01, March would be 03. Use four digits for the year, example 1999.
GENDER (M/F)	Code M for male and F for female.
RACE/ETHNICITY: (Choose appropriate number code) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1-American Indian</li> <li>• 2-African American</li> <li>• 3-Asian</li> <li>• 4-Hispanic</li> <li>• 5-Caucasian</li> </ul>	Choose the appropriate code number for the child's race/ethnicity. The system is confined to these five codes. If in question, it is usually the practice to use the mother's race/ethnicity as the dominant race/ethnicity representation.
PRIMARY LANGUAGE SPOKEN AT HOME	Write the dominant language spoken in the home.
CHILD RECEIVES SPECIAL EDUCATION AND HAS AN IEP (Y/N)	Include only children that have an IEP/IFSP. If a child acquires an IEP/IFSP during the year, please include this in his/her updated data table.
SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER (OPTIONAL)	This is optional and NOT required.
DATE CHILD ENTERED PROGRAM (MM/DD/YYYY)	Indicate the date the child began the program.
DATE CHILD EXITED PROGRAM (MM/DD/YYYY)	Indicate the date the child exited the program. Use numbers to represent months (January is 01, March is 03). Represent the year using four digits, such as 1999.
EXIT REASON (Choose only one)	Indicate the reason the child exited the program. You can choose only one reason.
