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Executive Summary

The Delaware Department of Education report on secondary schools dropouts is from data collected annually. Delaware collects data from all public schools including grades 7 through 12, but calculates the yearly dropout rate from grades 9 through 12, as is prescribed by the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES). Information is gathered from families that home school their children as well as from private schools. The data from private and home schools are only used to verify the transfers from public to private and home schools. This report does not contain data reflecting private, parochial or home schooled students in Delaware.

Delaware complies with the National Center for Educational Statistics requirements for reporting and uses the Event Rate method for our reporting. Event Rate reporting is a snapshot which reflects the total number of students (grades 9-12) who dropped out of school in a single year divided by the fall enrollment of the same year.

Definition of Dropout: A 2006-2007 dropout is an individual who:

Was enrolled at the end of the 2005-2006 school year or was enrolled at any time during the 2006-2007 school year, was not enrolled on September 30, 2007 and

- Has not graduated from high school or completed a state or district-approved educational program; and

Does not meet any of the following exclusionary conditions:

- Documentation proving transfer to another public school district, private school, or state- or district-approved education program;
- Temporary absence due to suspension or school-approved illness; or
- Death.

Criteria for being reported as a dropout:

1. Students who completed the 2006-2007 school year and were expected to enroll in grades 7-12 in the 2006-2007 school year, but did not do so, are considered dropouts (no-shows) from the receiving school. These “no-shows” should have a withdrawal date that is the same as the entry date.
2. If a student has moved and there is no evidence (parent signature/request for records) that he/she has transferred to another school, he/she is counted as a dropout.

3. Students who transfer to James H. Groves Adult High School, and subsequently drop out before June 15, 2007, are counted as dropouts from the home school.
4. Students who transfer to James H. Groves Adult Basic Education (ABE) programs are counted as dropouts from the home school.
5. Expelled students are counted as dropouts unless they have the option to return to school at the end of the disciplinary period. Those students who have the option to return but do not do so are counted as dropouts.
6. School leavers who have joined the military or Job Corp are counted as dropouts.

Criteria for not being counted as a dropout:

1. Students receiving a diploma or a “Record of Performance” are not reported as dropouts.
2. Transfers to another public or private school are not reported as dropouts. Documentation of transfers need to be preserved.
3. Students who die are not reported as dropouts.
4. School leavers who are in correctional institutions or other state agencies are not counted as dropouts.

Dropout Reason Codes

Beginning with the 2006-07 school year, the dropout reason codes have been incorporated into Exit/Withdrawal codes. The following is a list of the dropout codes:

For the 2006-2007 school-year, 2026 of the 37,252 students enrolled in grades 9-12 dropped out of school. The 2006-2007 dropout rate was **5.4 percent** (a slight decrease from 2005-2006) which was the second year of decrease in dropouts.

Table 12 has an additional feature this year. A three-year average rate has been calculated in addition to district trend data. We have chosen to include this rate because it is more stable than one-year rates and we believe that viewing trend data may better serve those who work with programs to improve student outcomes.

Student enrollment in high schools has been increasing and we believe this is due to other education options available to students rather than dropping out. Through all of the Delaware Department of Education's efforts in secondary education reform and our heightened awareness of programs that improve graduation outcomes we expect to see more students continuing in high school until graduation. All school districts have implemented various credit recovery programs which seem to be making an impact on the numbers of students remaining in school. Data are being collected on these programs, but it will take another year to determine how much impact they are truly having on providing students with opportunities to complete their education or "catch up" with their cohorts.

Through the efforts of the state Dropout Prevention Committee, information has been continually shared to address dropout issues. Presentations to the committee from practitioners are activities that have provided the districts with information and examples to improve student outcomes within Delaware secondary schools. National and regional models highlighting best practices have been reviewed, members have attended and presented at The National Dropout Prevention Network conferences and have developed a community of practice within the state to share those ideas that show promise. As a result of these efforts we believe that the dropout rate is on a slow but steady decline.

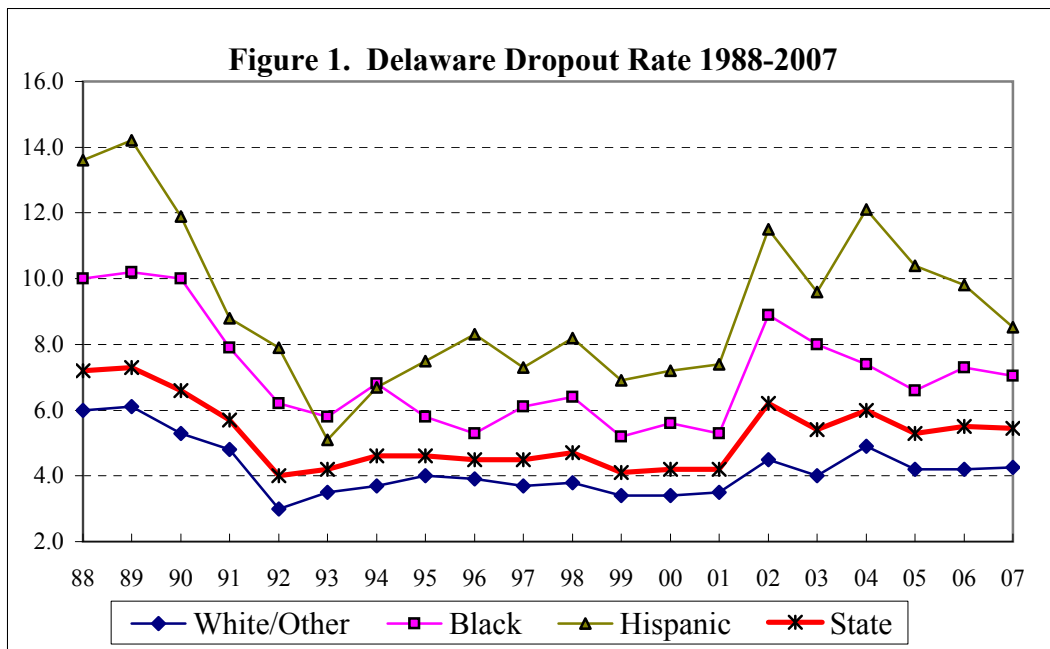

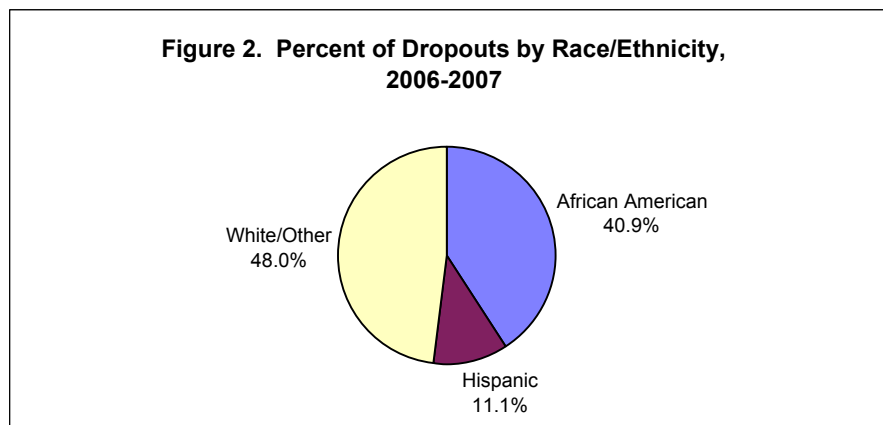


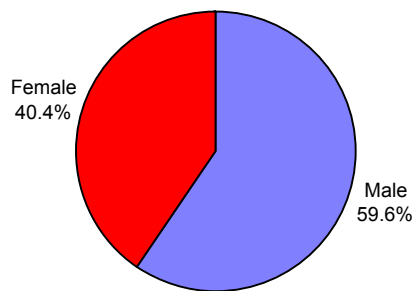

2006-2007**

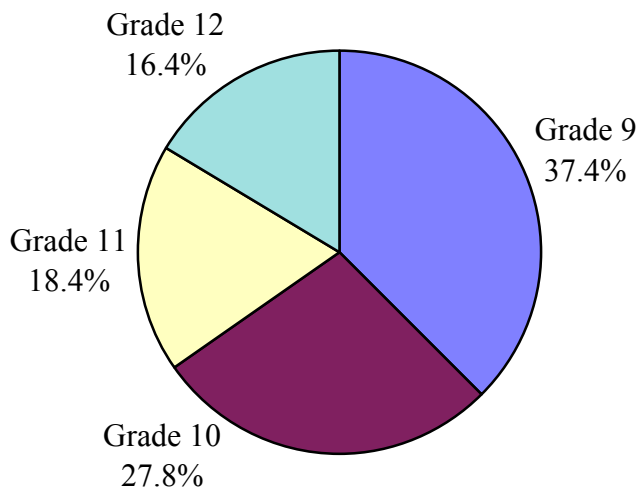


Figure 5. Dropout Rate by Gender by Race, 2006-2007

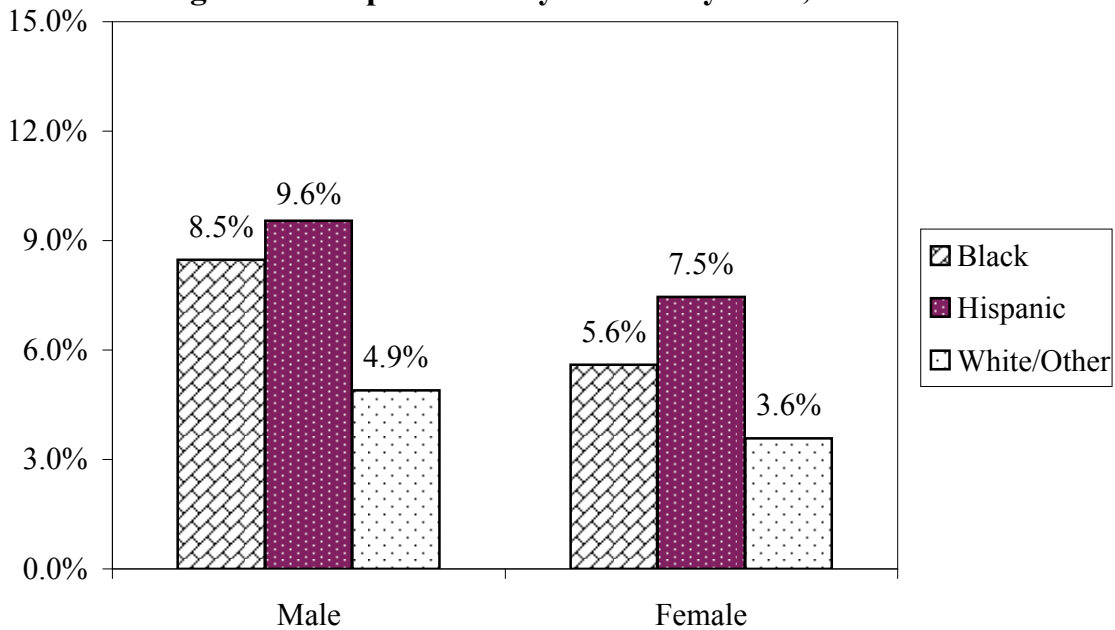

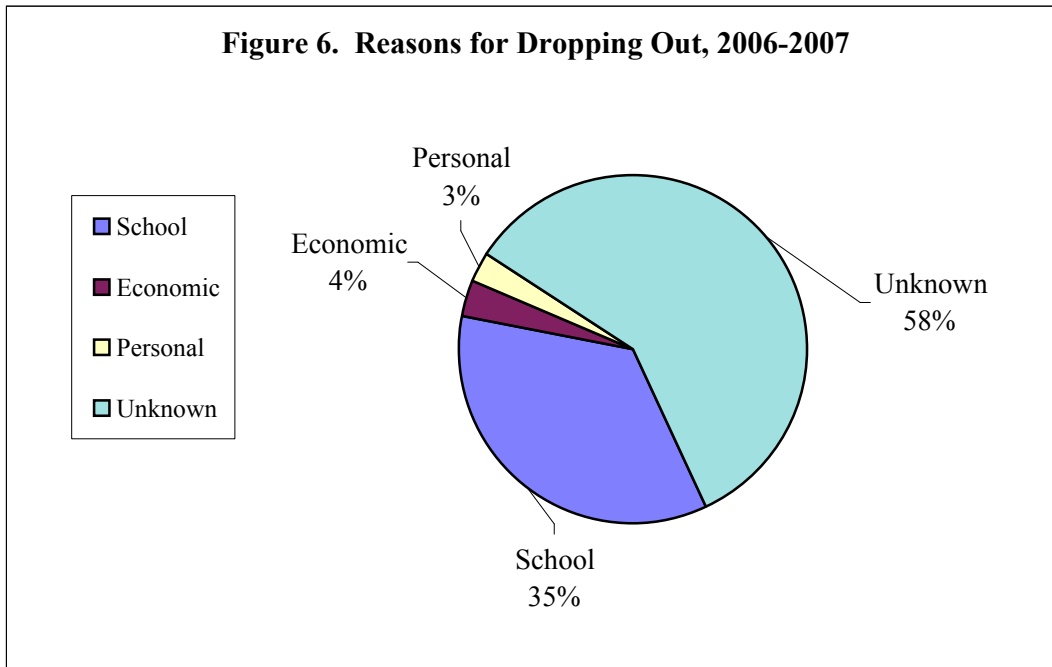

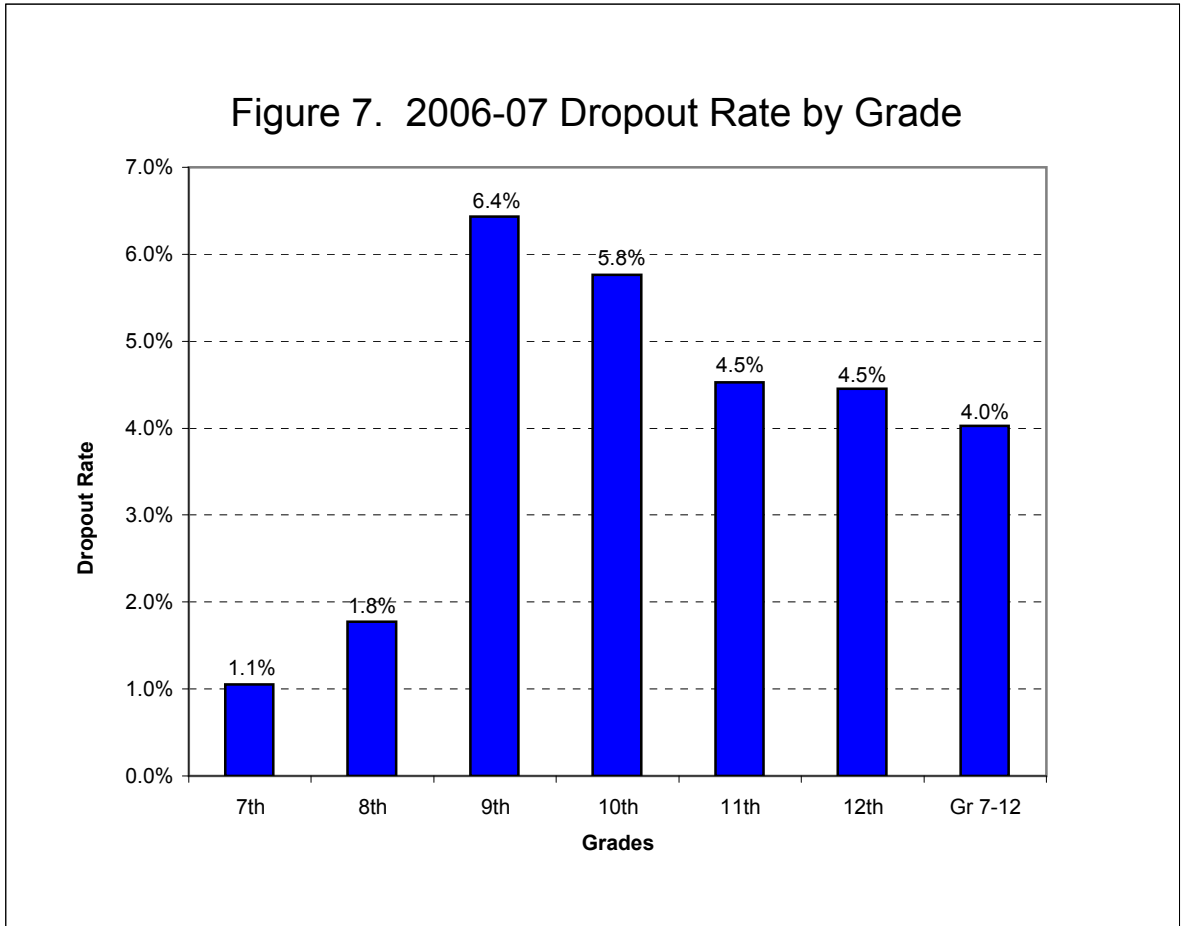

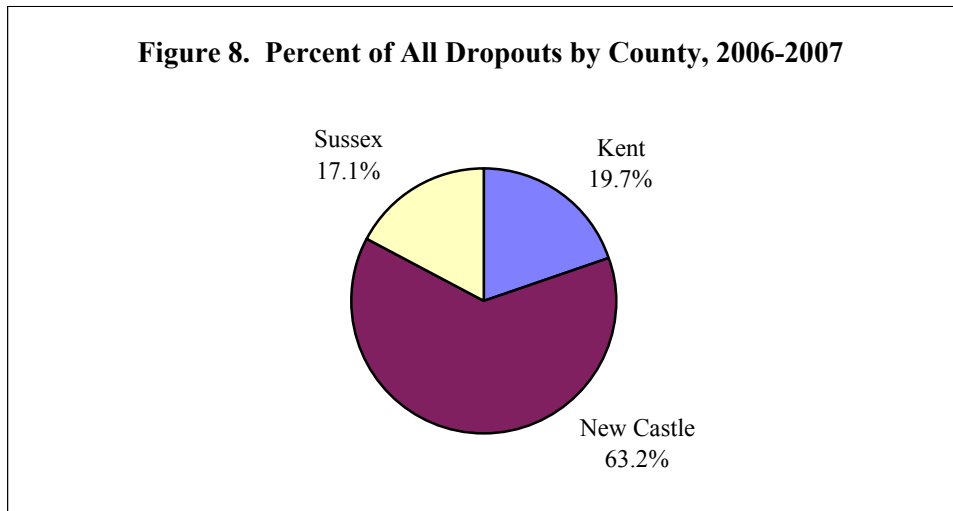

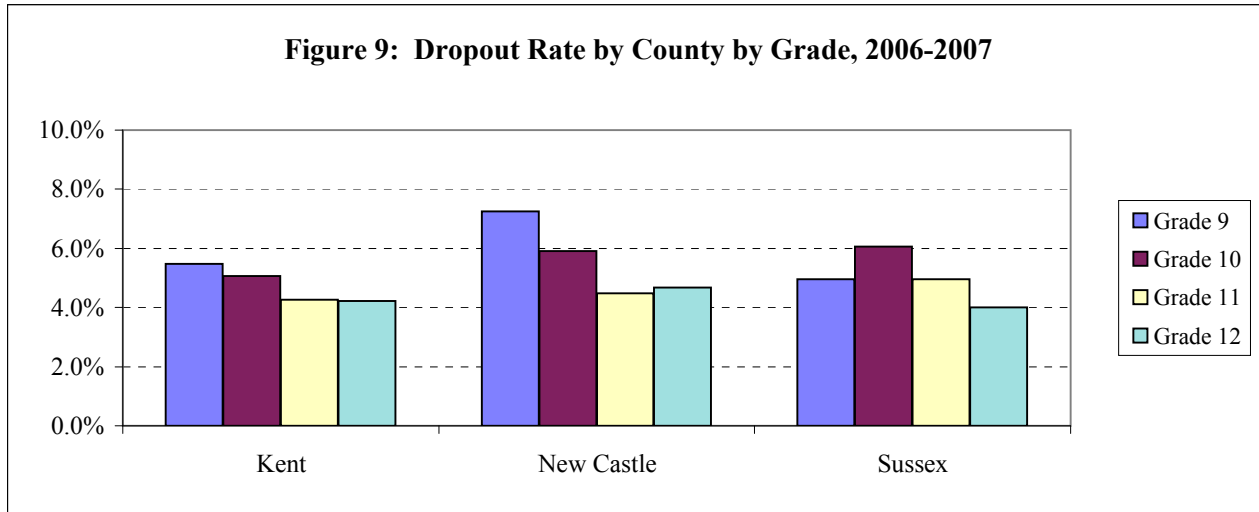

Figure 10. Dropout Rate by District, 2006-2007

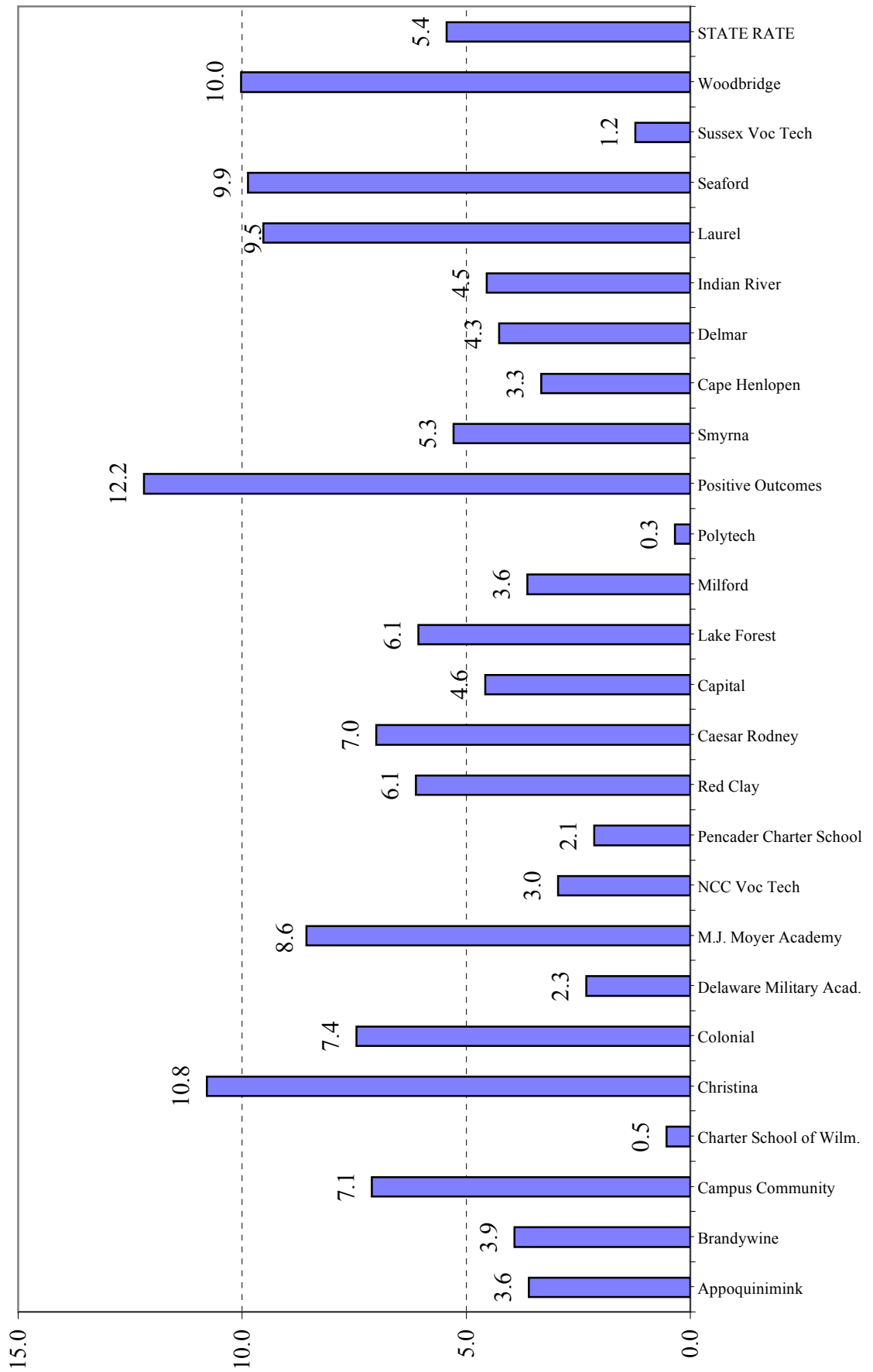

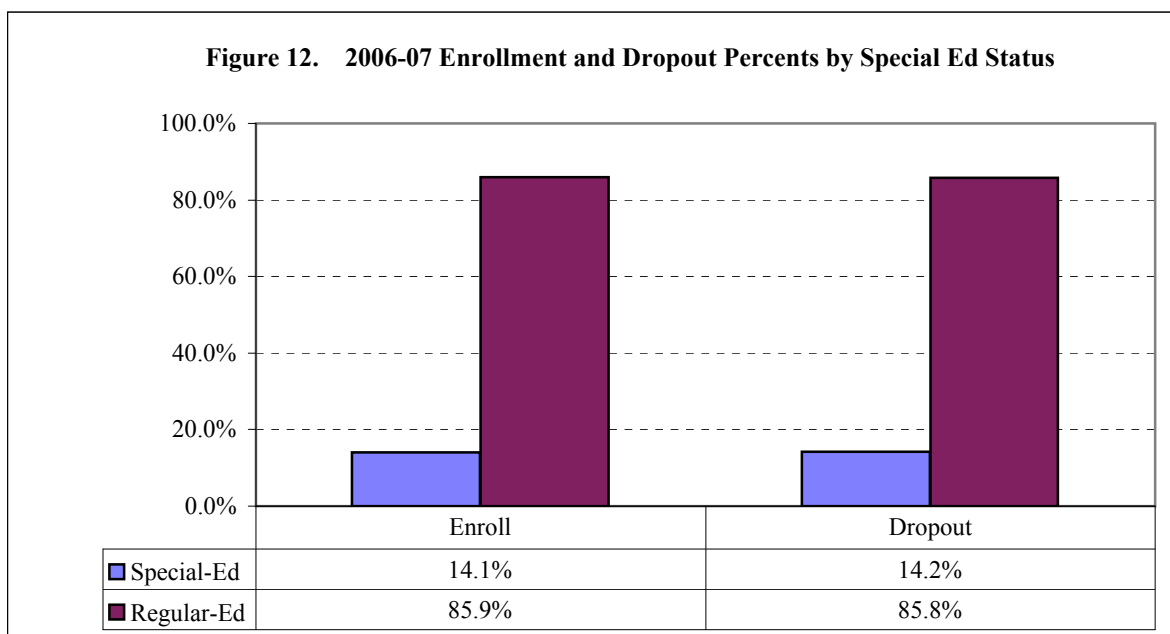
