

NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS INFORMATION

The Department of Education annually collects and reports selected information pertaining to pupils enrolled in kindergarten through grade twelve in nonpublic schools in the state. Pupil enrollment and attendance information for nonpublic schools is required by Section 2704, Title 14, *Delaware Code*. Schools are also required to provide summary counts of school staff. In addition, nonpublic schools provide the Department of Education the name, gender, race, grade, district of residence and type of transportation assistance requested for students enrolled in grades kindergarten through twelve. Tables in this section include out-of-state pupils attending Delaware nonpublic schools, as well.
