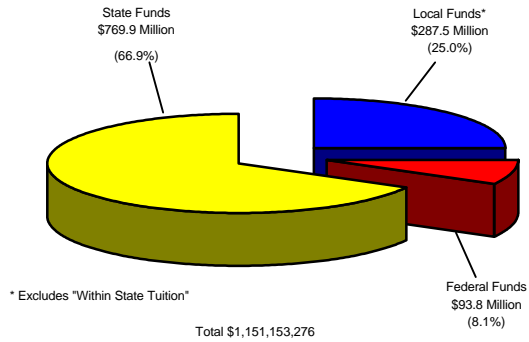
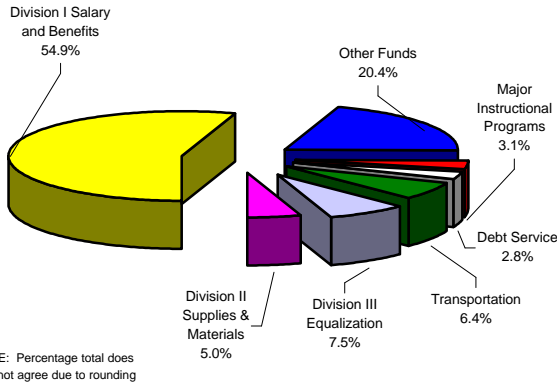

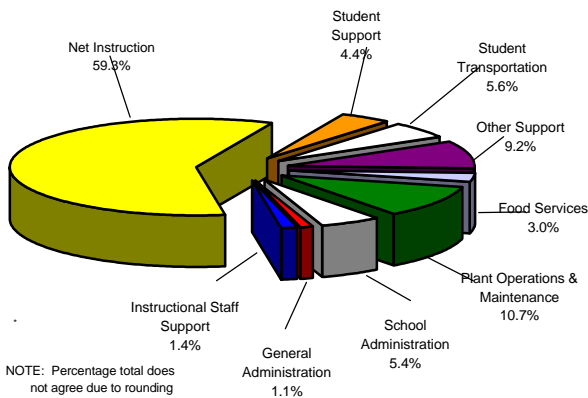
**Sources of Educational Revenue**

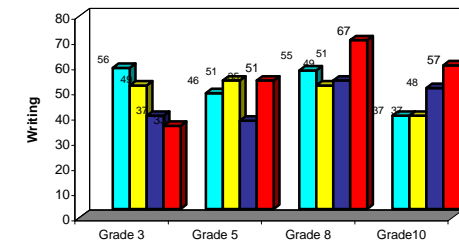
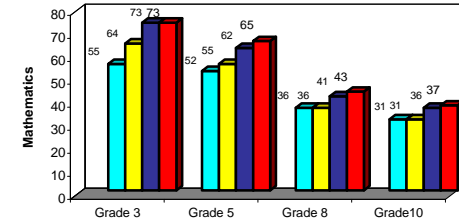
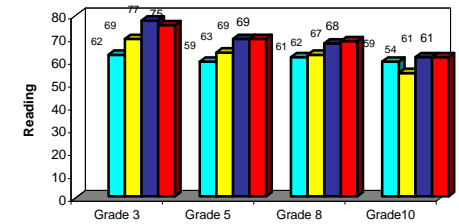
