### Elementary K-3

- 50% of instructional day in each language
- Two-Teacher Model
- Immersion Content
  - Literacy
  - Math
  - Science
- English Content
  - Literacy (with social studies embedded)
  - Content Transfer / Academic Language Development

### Instructional Split: Grades K-3

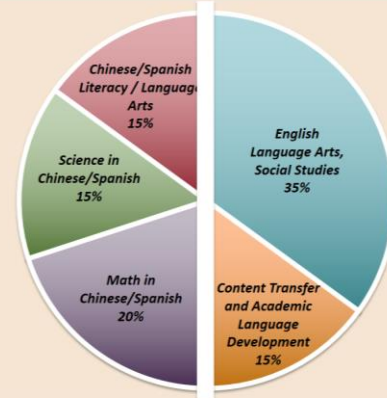
Target Language Literacy / Language Arts (50 minutes)

Science in Target Language (40 minutes)

Math in Target Language (60 minutes)

English Language Arts (120 minutes)

Content Transfer / Academic Language Development (20-30 minutes)



### Elementary 4-5

- 50% of instructional day in each language
- Two-Teacher Model
- Immersion Content
  - Literacy
  - Math
  - Science
- English Content
  - Literacy
  - Social Studies (stand-alone)
  - Content Transfer / Academic Language Development

### Instructional Split: Grades 4-5

Target Language Literacy / Language Arts (60 minutes)

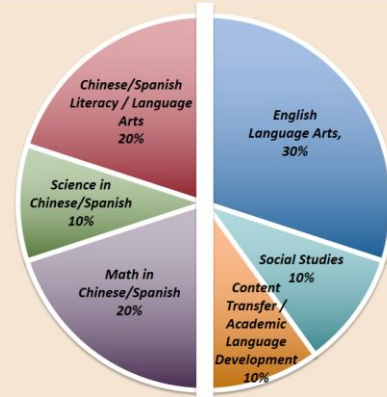
Science in Target Language (30 minutes)

Math in Target Language (60 minutes)

English Language Arts (100 minutes)

Social Studies in English (30 minutes)

Content Transfer / Academic Language Development (20 minutes)



### Middle School 6-8

- 35% of instructional day in immersion language
- One-Teacher Model
- Immersion Content
  - Literacy
  - Social Studies
- English Content
  - Literacy
  - Math
  - Science
  - Electives

Target Language Literacy / Language Arts (45 minutes)

Social Studies in Target Language (45 minutes)

English Language Arts (45 minutes)

Math (45 minutes)

Science (45 minutes)

Electives (45 minutes)
