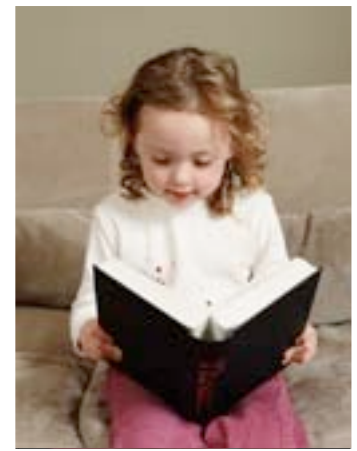

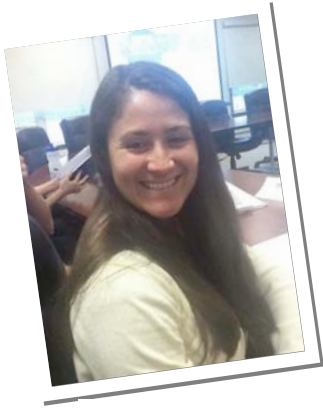

Members of the Delaware World Language Teacher Leader Network have elected a Network Board of six people: one representative from each of the three counties, one district curriculum supervisor whose duties include the supervision of world language teachers, an invited university world language teacher educator and the Education Associate for World Languages at the Delaware Department of Education. The Board will serve a two-year term.

New Castle County elected Holly Schnittger, Italian Teacher from McKean High School in Red Clay to be their Board Representative. Linda Smith, French Teacher at Dover High School in the Capital School District, was elected to represent Kent County. As its representative, Sussex County elected

Kristen Roach, Spanish teacher at Indian River High School in the Indian River School District. The entire World Language Teacher Leader Network unanimously voted for Sandy Spangler from the Capital School District to be the District Curriculum Supervisor representative.

Dr. Ali Alalou from the University of Delaware will serve as the university representative on the Board.

From within the Board, Kristen Roach (Sussex County) was elected to serve as the Board Chair (2011-2013) and Holly Schnittger (New Castle County) will be the Chair Elect (2012-2013) and will then assume the position of Board Chair (2013-2015).

The purpose of the Network Board is to

- Establish and approve operating policies and practices for the Delaware World Language Teacher Leader Network that promote the goals of improving world language learning throughout the state;
- Take a leadership role in developing and overseeing a strategic plan for K-12 world language learning in Delaware, including teacher professional development;
- Promote partnerships among the state's districts, charter schools and universities to enhance the learning of world language K-12.
