## RE: $\quad 2023$ Operational Memo \#9 Area Eligibility Percentages for SY 22-23

USDA Regulations mandate that At-Risk Programs and Day Care Homes (for tiering) in CACFP use free and reduced-price meal data from schools for determining area eligibility. Per 7 CFR §226.2 Definitions:

Eligible area means:
(a) For the purpose of determining the eligibility of at-risk afterschool care centers, the attendance area of a school in which at least 50 percent of the enrolled children are certified eligible for free or reduced-price school meals; or
(b) For the purpose of determining the tiering status of day care homes, the attendance area of a school in which at least 50 percent of the enrolled children are certified eligible for free or reduced-price meals, or the area based on the most recent census data in which at least 50 percent of the children residing in the area are members of households that meet the income standards for free or reduced-price meals.

The attached document reflects percentages of free and reduced populations by school. All schools in red are participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Nutrition and the percentages listed are the free claiming percentage for the school. This data is current as of October 2022.

Please use this document when determining eligibility for CACFP At Risk Programs and Family Day Care Homes tiering.
