The Odyssey School Community was extremely pleased to learn of the results of the Delaware Department of Education (DE DOE) Charter School Renewal Report presented to us recently. In this report, Odyssey Charter School received an overall academic rating of **"Exceeds Standard"** in the 2012-2013 school year, with a composite score of 91 points. In school years 2010-2011 and 2011-2012, Odyssey received an overall rating of "Meets Standard" with a total of 76 points in 2011-12 and 67 points in 2010-2011.

This is an outstanding improvement and accomplishment by our teachers, support staff, administration and school board in delivering high quality curriculum and instruction at our school. It is our highest rating since the initiation of the performance framework. We are all exceptionally proud of this accomplishment by our students and staff.

In two other areas, Financial Performance and Organizational Performance, Odyssey continues to "Meet Standard." We will review and refine our efforts and strive to earn the highest rating possible in all areas under the Charter School renewal process in the delivery of high quality education to our students.
