The goal of Providence Creek Academy's special education program is to identify all children with disabilities, accurately assess their eligibility and their learning needs as well as provide appropriate special education and related services. It is PCA's belief that all children are unique and have different ways of learning. It is with this belief that PCA will be an inclusive education system where students with special needs are fully participating members of a community of learners. PCA intends to provide appropriate service and programs to ensure it is equitable, relevant, accessible and accountable.

The school ensures that to the maximum extent appropriate, students with disabilities are educated with students who are non-disabled. Resource classes outside of the regular education classroom occur only if the nature or severity of the disability is such that education in regular classes with the use of supplementary aids and services cannot be achieved satisfactorily.
