Examples for discussion – Current State (including allowable transportation)

1. Student 1 – 3rd grader from her feeder pattern elementary school of North Georgetown Elementary in Georgetown would like to choice for her 4th grade year to:
 - Southern Delaware School of the Arts (Indian River magnet school in Selbyville)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation on a bus contracted with Indian River SD.
 - Rehoboth Elementary School (Inter-district choice to Cape Henlopen in Rehoboth-school is at 85% capacity)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in the Rehoboth ES feeder.
 - Lake Forest South (inter-district choice to Lake Forest in Harrington – school is below 85% capacity) (inter-district choice)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in the Lake Forest ES feeder.
 - Long Neck Elementary School (Intra-district choice within IR school district in Millsboro)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in the Long Neck ES feeder.

2. Student 2 – 8th grader from his feeder pattern high school of Christiana High School in Newark would like to choice for his 9th grade year to:
 - First State Military High School (charter school in Clayton)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation on a bus contracted with the charter school.
 - St. Georges High School (NCCVT vocational technical school in Middletown)
 - If accepted to St Georges HS, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation from their neighborhood bus stop on a bus contracted with the NCCVT District.
 - Glasgow High School (intra-district choice within Christina school district in Newark)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in the Glasgow HS feeder.

- Brandywine High School (inter-district choice in Brandywine school district in Wilmington)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in the Brandywine HS feeder.

3. Student 3 – 5th grader from choice school of Newark Charter School in Newark and who lives in Newark would like to choice for her 6th grade year to:
 - Gauger-Cobbs Middle School (feeder pattern school)
 - The student will be eligible for school bus transportation from a neighborhood stop to go to their feeder school.
 - Kirk Middle School (intra-district choice within Christina school district)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in the Kirk MS feeder.
 - Meredith Middle School (Inter-district choice within Appoquinimink school district in Middletown)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in the Meredith MS feeder.
 - Kuumba Academy (charter school in Wilmington)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation on a bus contracted with the charter school.
 - Cab Calloway (magnet school in Red Clay school district)
 - If accepted for choice, the student would be eligible for school bus transportation but must go to the closest existing stop in Red Clay SD feeder.
