The Executive Director, the Principal and the Board of the Delaware STEM Academy have shown through the documentation provided that the school will deliver the educational program with fidelity and is financially viable in accordance with the approved Charter.

This has been accomplished with the addition of staff, including teachers and paraprofessionals that will address the needs of those students identified as a special population group and by restructuring contracts for support services.

We continue to enroll students (131 first year contracts as of June 10, 2016) who desire to attend the Delaware STEM Academy and its project based learning model.

We look forward to receiving confirmation that we have addressed all concerns and that we can continue with the opening of the school.
