New Tech Network is partnering with Delaware STEM Academy to provide training and support to our school as we implement the project based learning platform and this differentiated system of learning. As part of that training our teachers will be participating in the following events:

- June 21-22 Teacher Residency (on site) to introduce the model and conceptual shifts
 - What is PBL
 - How to create a classroom culture around collaboration
 - Using core values to establish a trust card system around trust, respect and responsibility
 - Curriculum mapping with updating current maps to include shifts with PBL model
 - Strategies for scaffolding and intervention
 - How technology plays a critical role in enabling students in PBL
 - How to engage students in a deeper learning model school
 - How to promote critical thinking skills in a student-centered environment
 - Virtual Teacher Panel from a partner New Tech School
 - Introduction to role play scenarios with students
- July 11-15 New Tech Annual Conference (Orlando) all staff will participate in a new school intensive training (see sample agenda below).
- September/October (TBD) Teacher Residency-Part II with a visit to an exemplary school as a follow up to the intensive training and collaboration with other schools as a “meeting of the minds” event, ongoing peer mentoring with school as well as individual teacher pairings.
- Weekly/Monthly Professional Development-The New Tech Academic coach will be available to visit the school and conduct walk-throughs for feedback and support purposes, implement professional development sessions based on the needs of the school, academic program or school climate.
