
I am pleased to inform you that on December 20, 2018, with the assent of the State Board of Education, the Department of Education approved the charter renewal application for Newark Charter School. Since Newark Charter School has demonstrated an outstanding record of performance, the charter has been approved for a ten year term. The new charter will be in effect from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2029. Please note that your next charter renewal application is due on September 30, 2028.

In accordance with 14 *Del. Code* § 514A (b), any charter school receiving such an extended renewal term shall, at the midpoint of the 10-year charter, be subject to an annual performance and program evaluation that includes academic, financial, and organizational performance framework data encompassing the school's performance during this time period. Please note that your midpoint evaluation is scheduled for September 30, 2023.

The Charter School Office will reach out to you over the next few months to discuss your Performance Agreement and Contract.
