

NAEP Administration




- January to March 2022

 - English learners




- Scale Scores

 - NAEP Advanced






Grade 4 Mathematics Results




Average Scale Scores






Grade 8 Mathematics Results




Average Scale Scores








Grade 4 Reading Results




Average Scale Scores




Average Scale Scores
