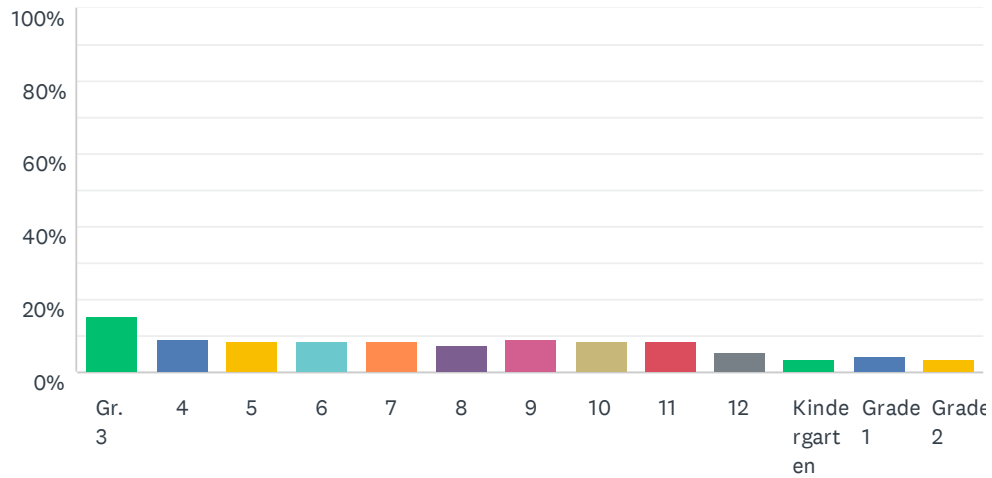


## Q19 What grade is your child in?

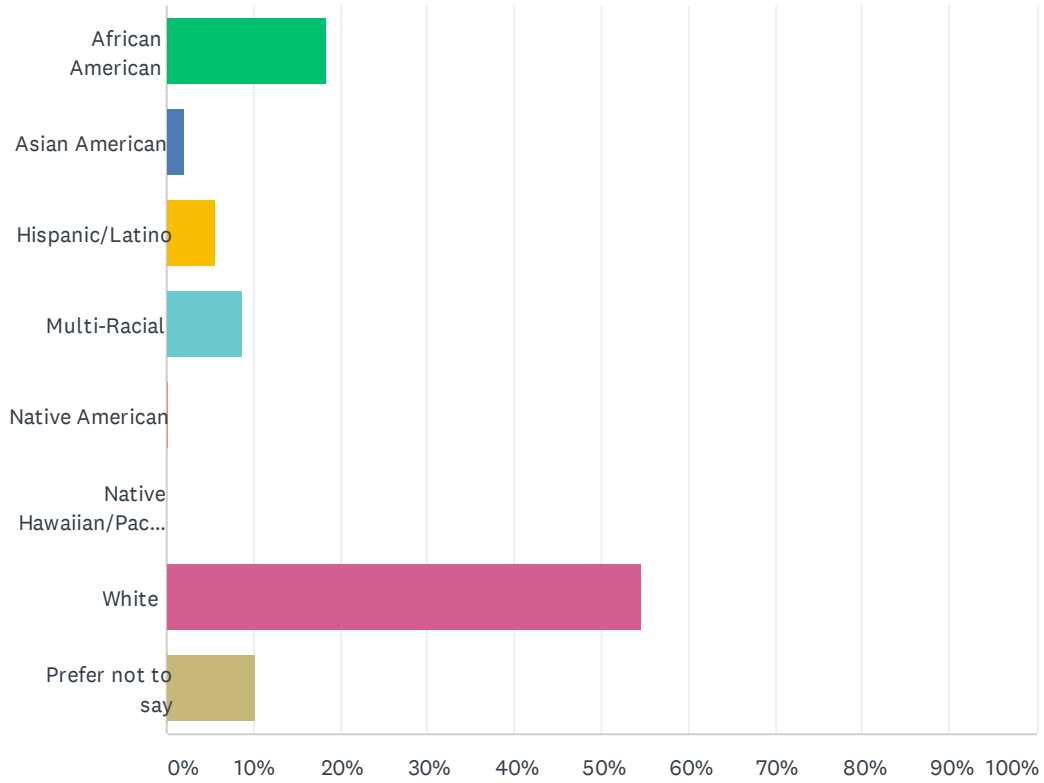

## Q20 What is your child's race/ethnicity?

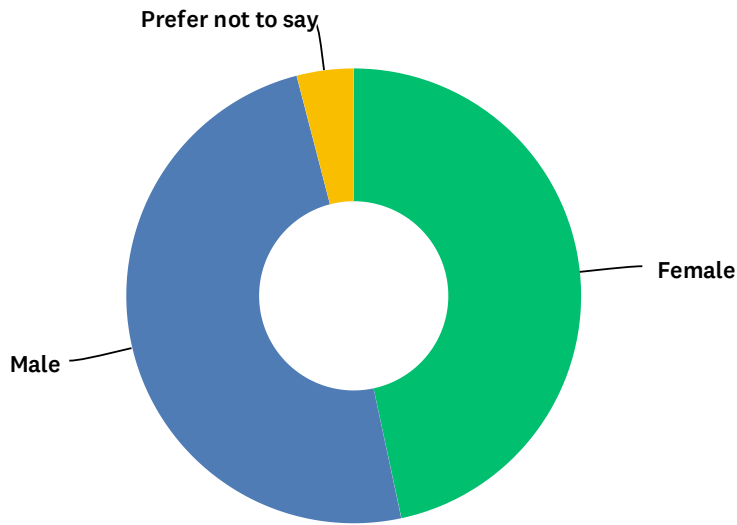

## Q21 What is your child's gender?

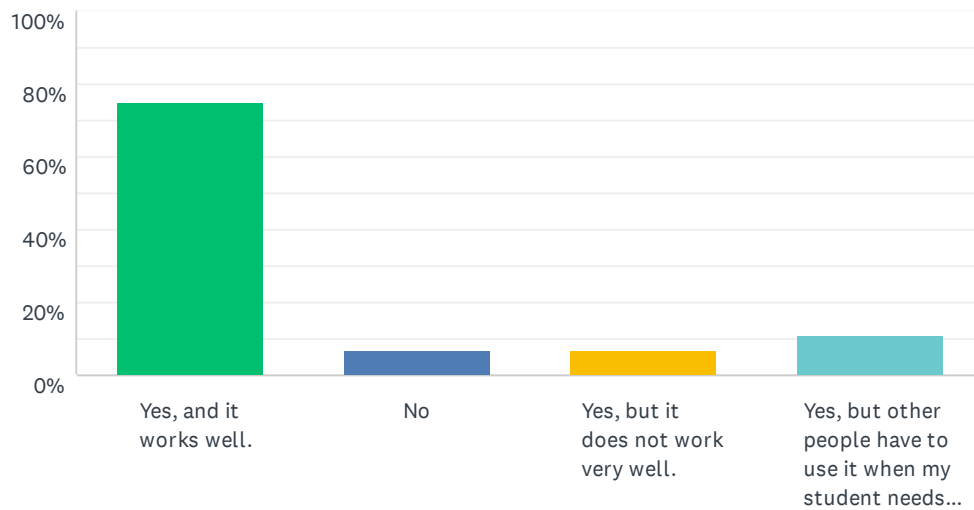

## Q24 Does your student have access to a computer or device (other than a smartphone) they can use to complete their school work?

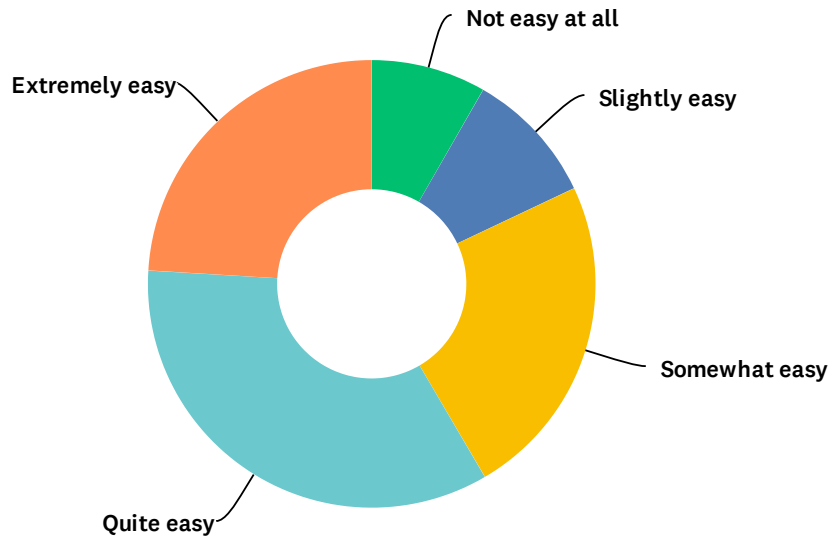

## Q25 How easy is it for your student to use the remote learning tools their school provided (video calls, Google sites, Schoology, etc.)?

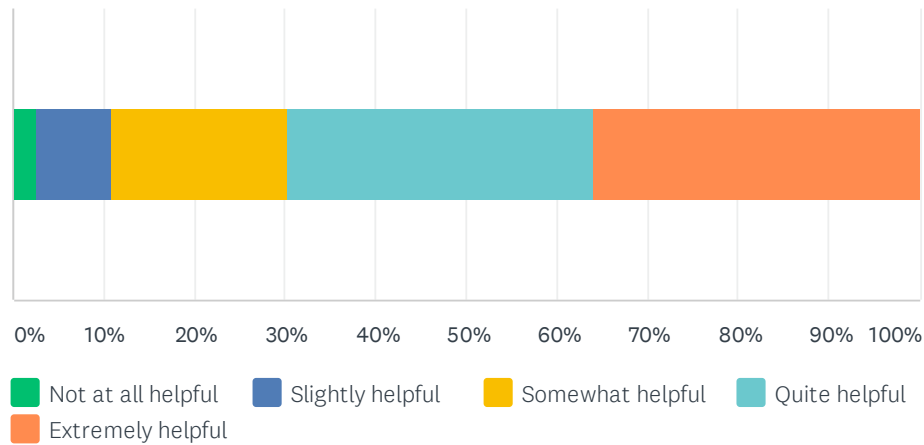

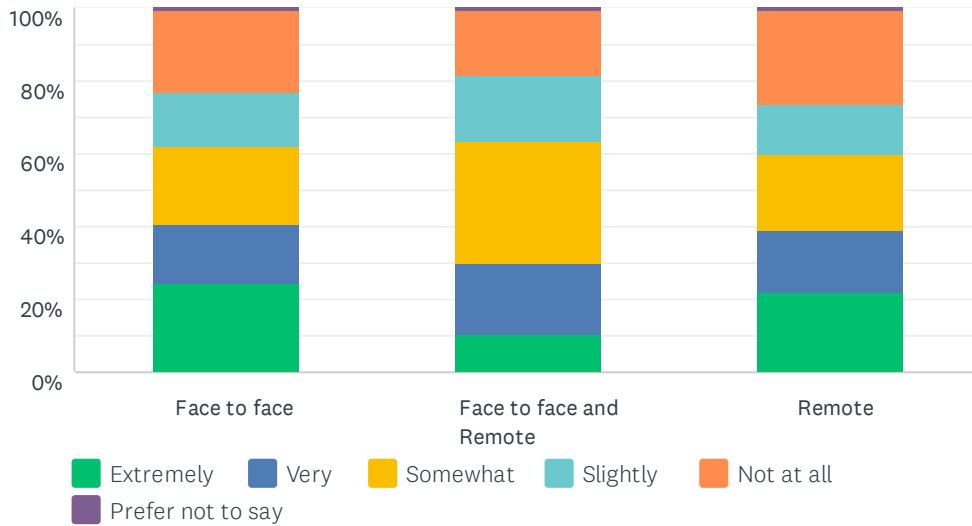

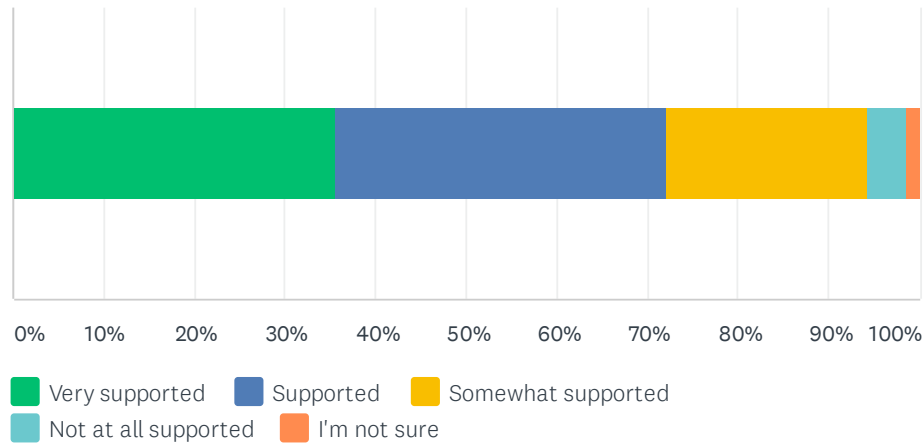

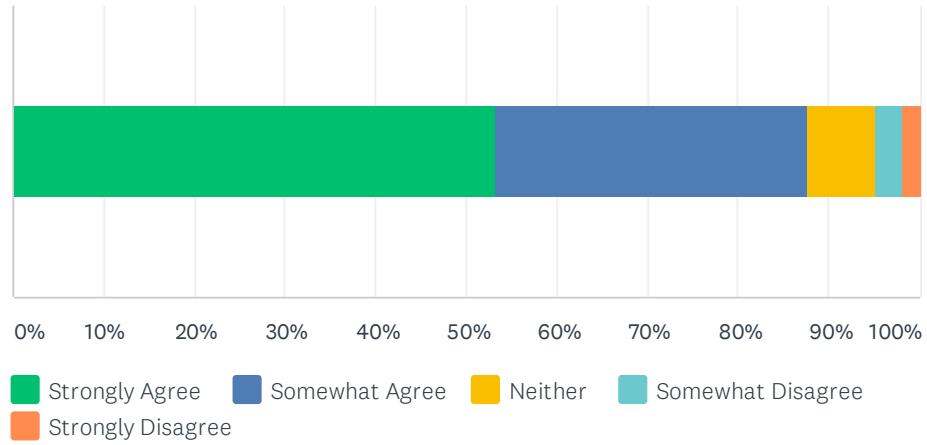

## Q40 My district uses methods of communication I prefer

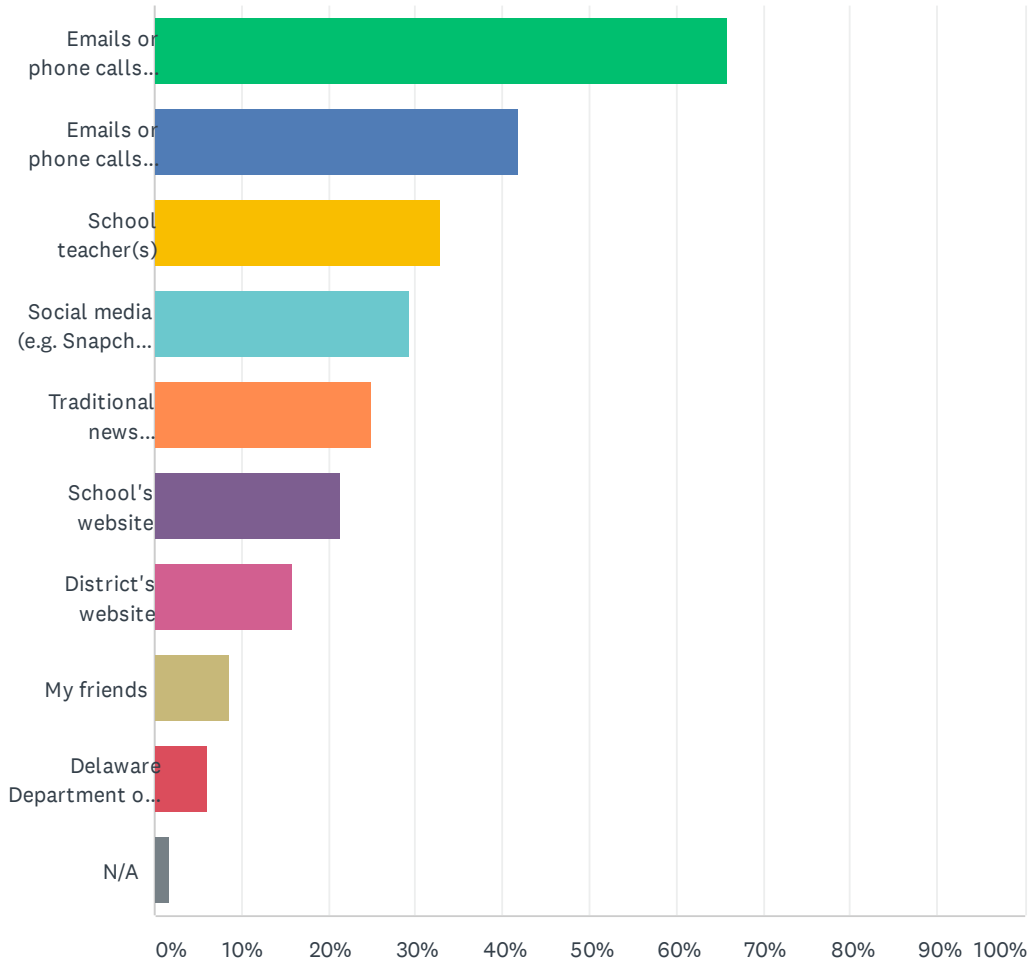

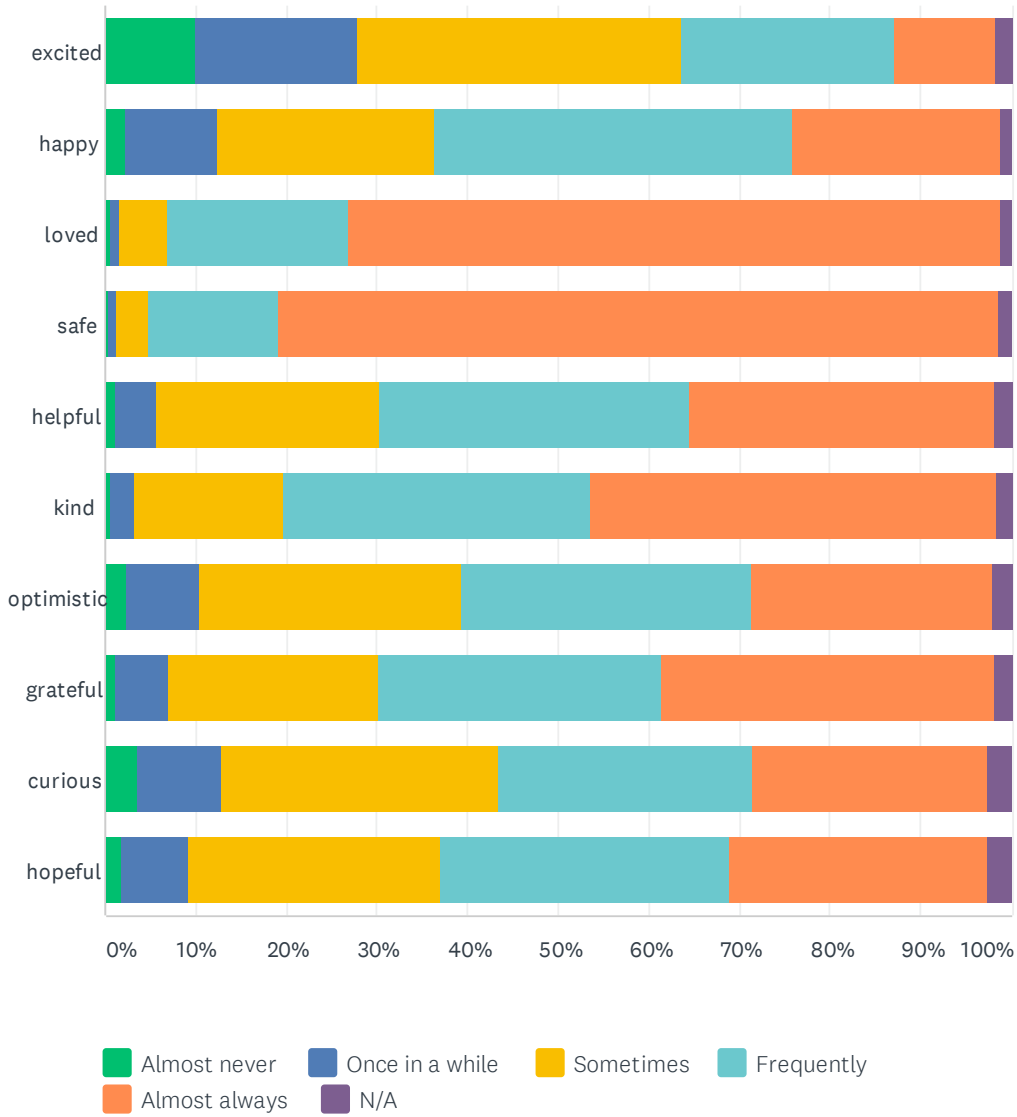

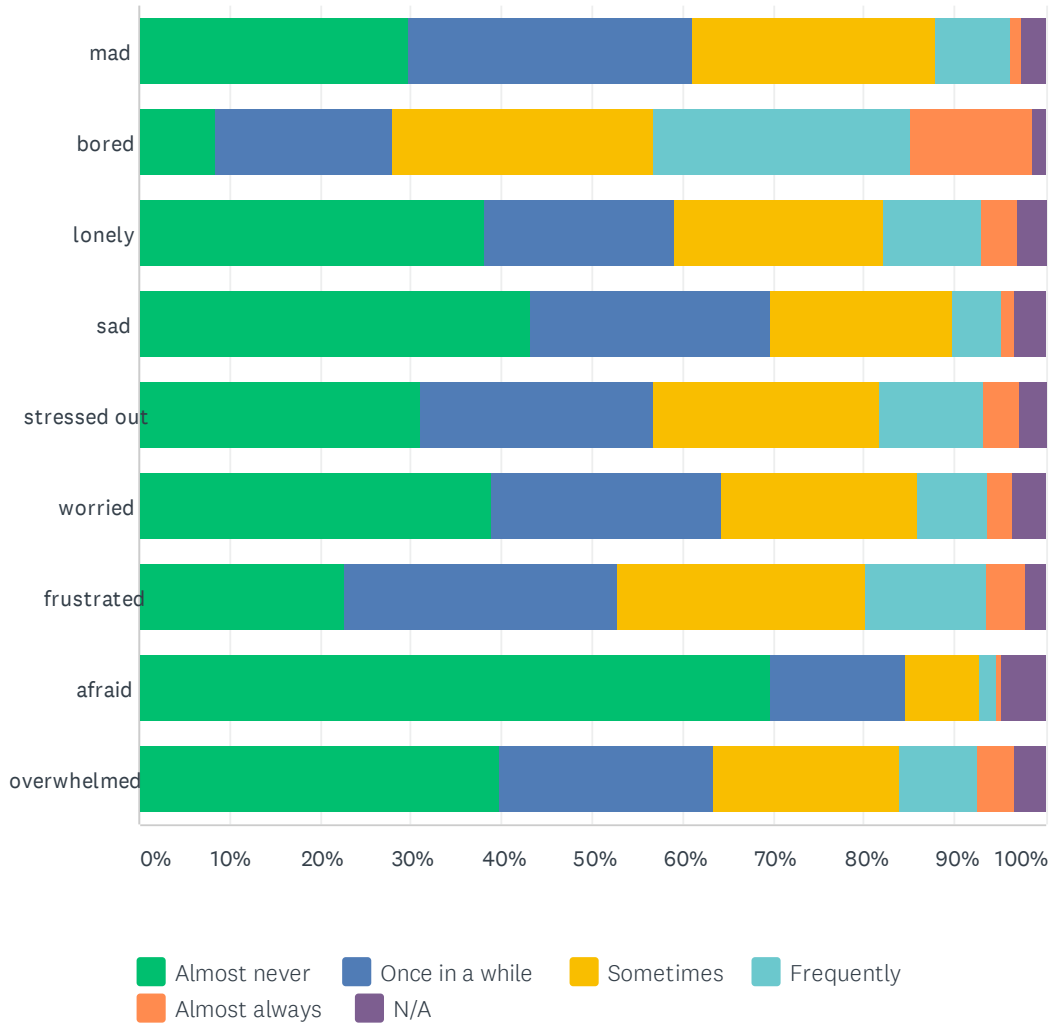
