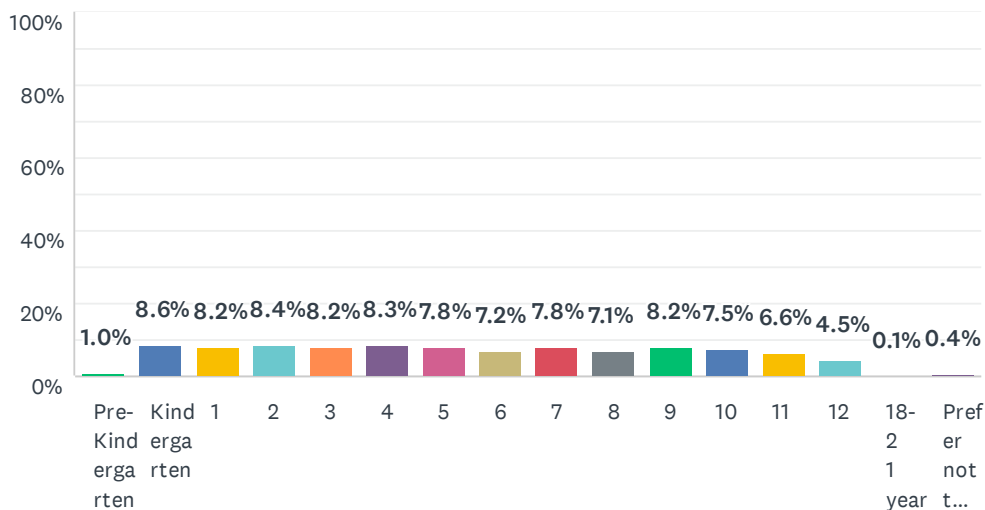

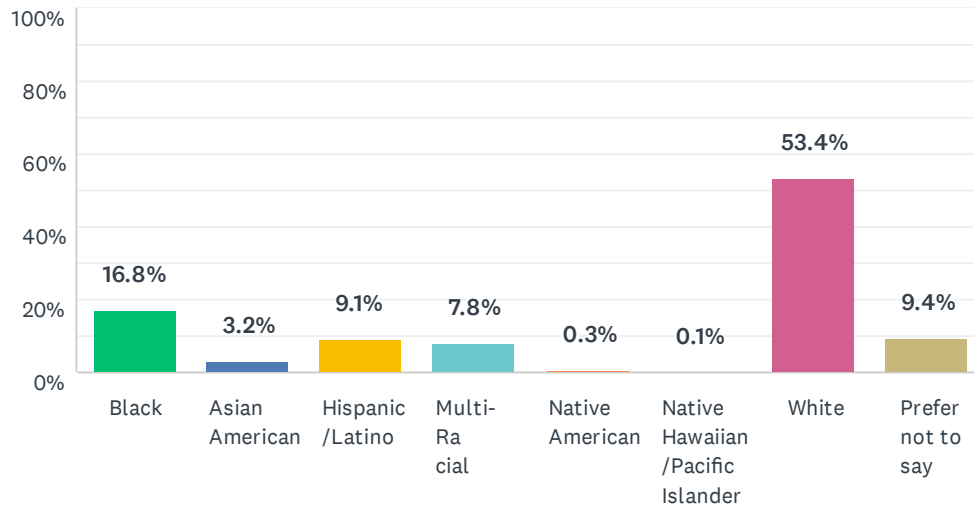

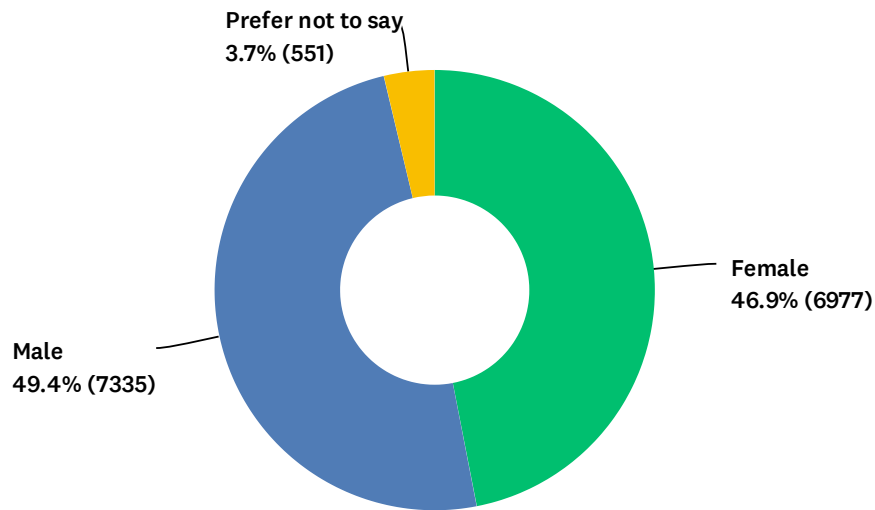

Q22 What is your child's gender?

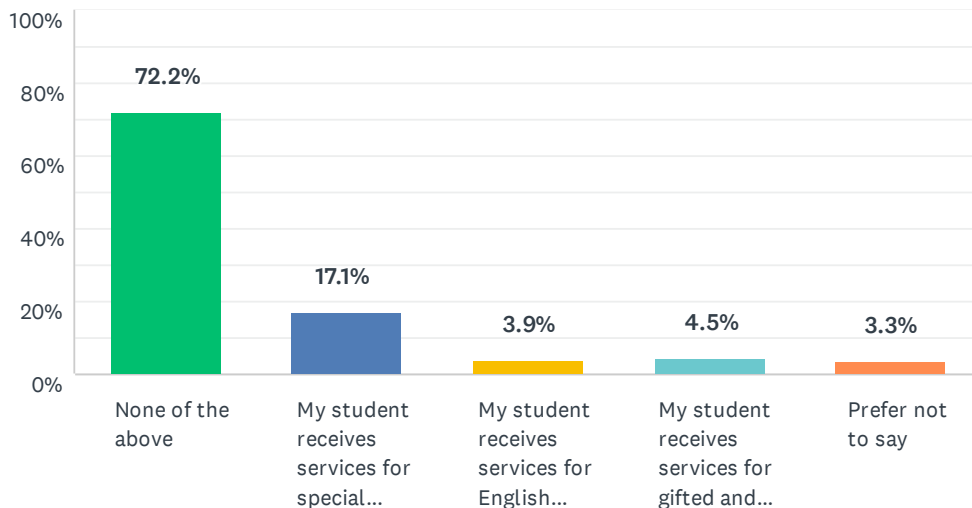

Q23 Which of the following is true for your child? (check all that apply)

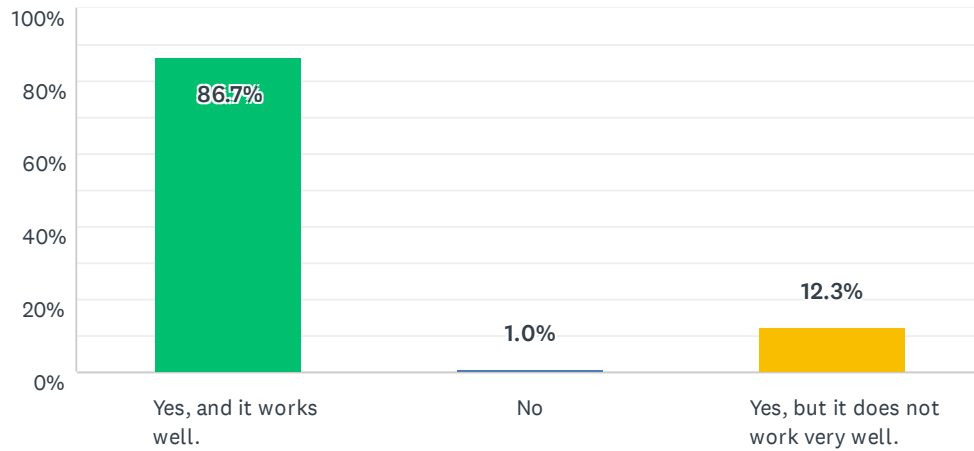

Q24 Does your household have internet access?

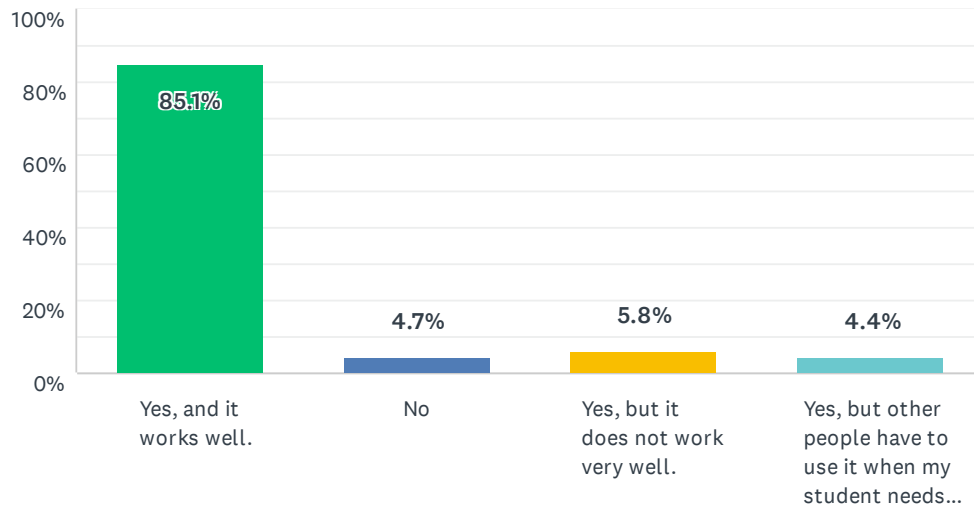

Q25 Does your student have access to a computer or device (other than a smartphone) he/she can use to complete school work?

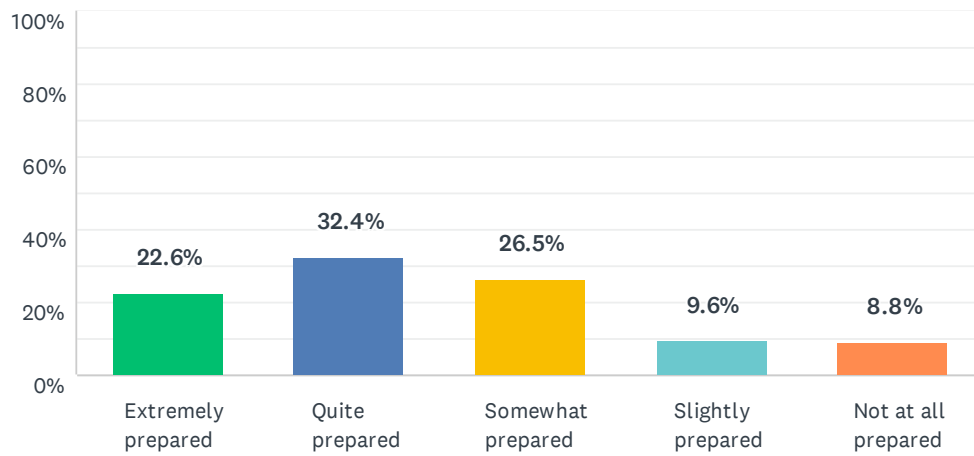

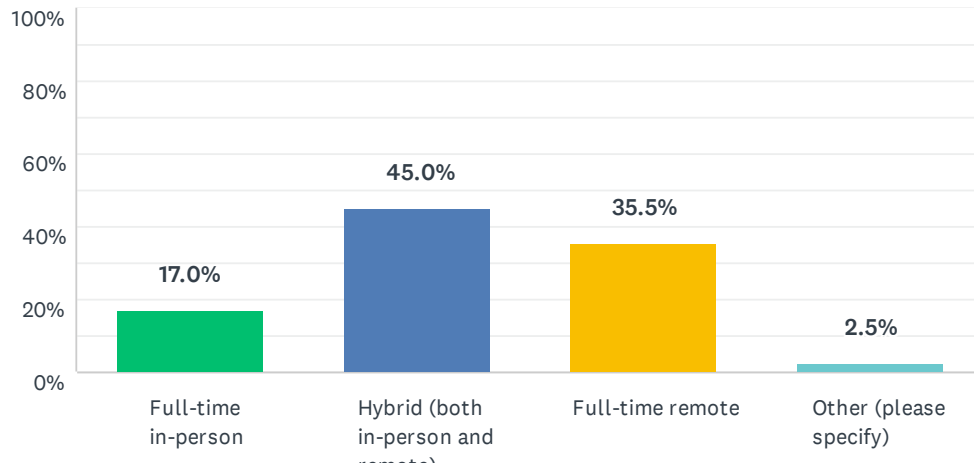

Q27 In what way is your student currently attending school?

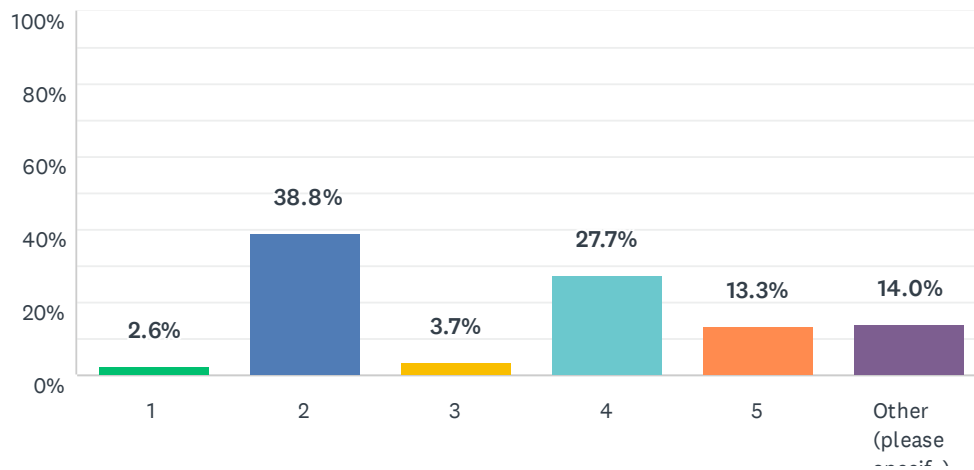

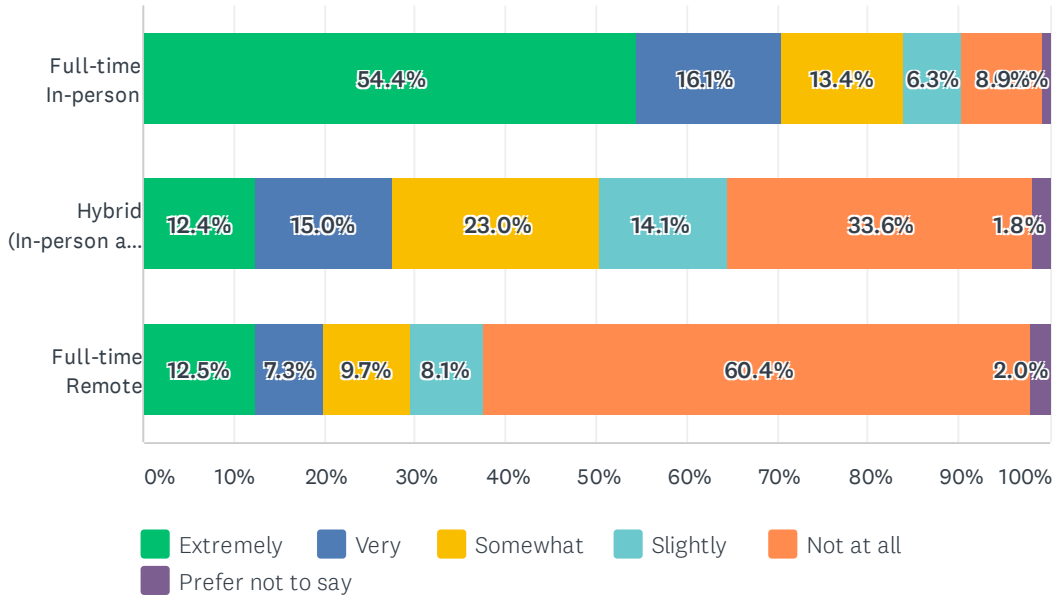

Q29 Given the current conditions, how comfortable would you be with the following choices of your student going to school at the beginning of next school year (2021-2022)?

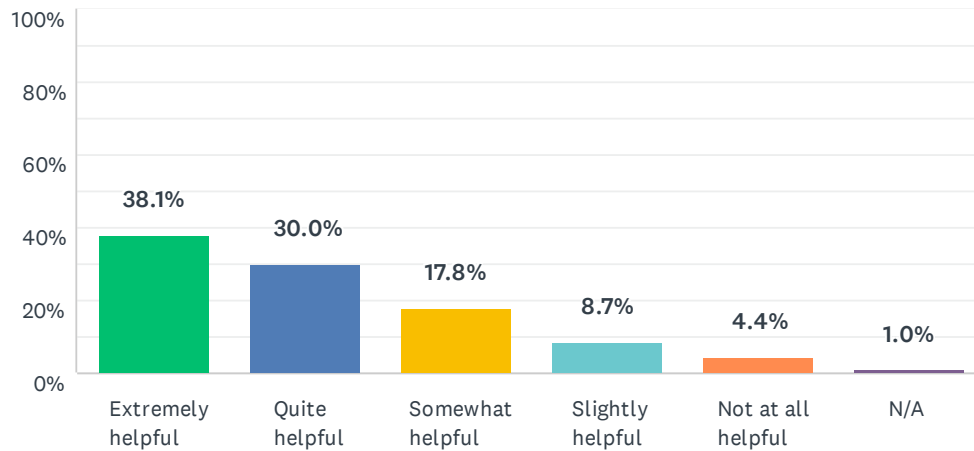

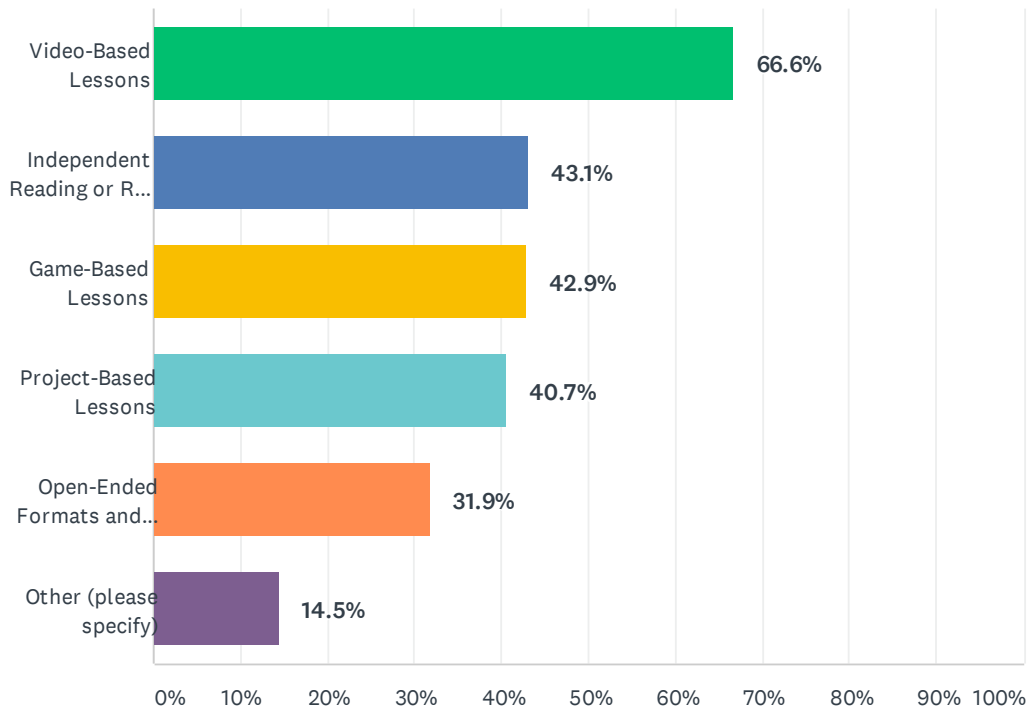

Q31 What did teachers do that made the lessons engaging (select all that apply)?

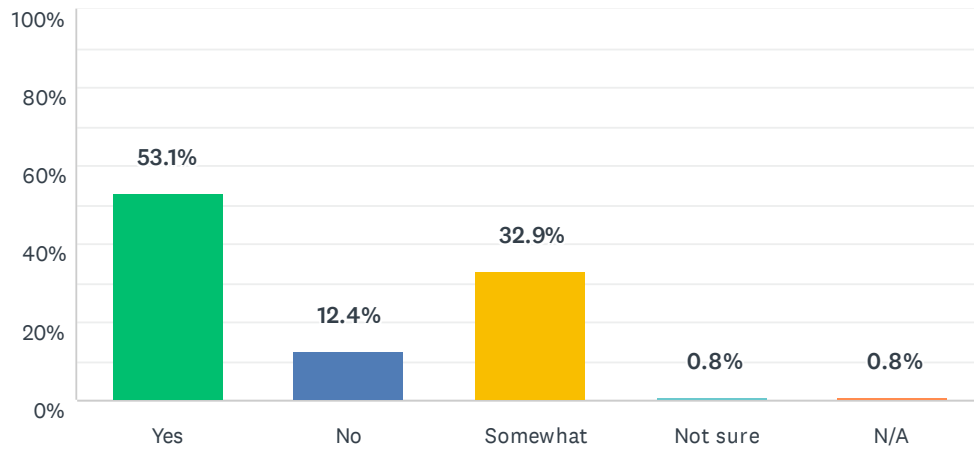

Q33 Is someone in your home able to help your student with instruction when he/she needs it?

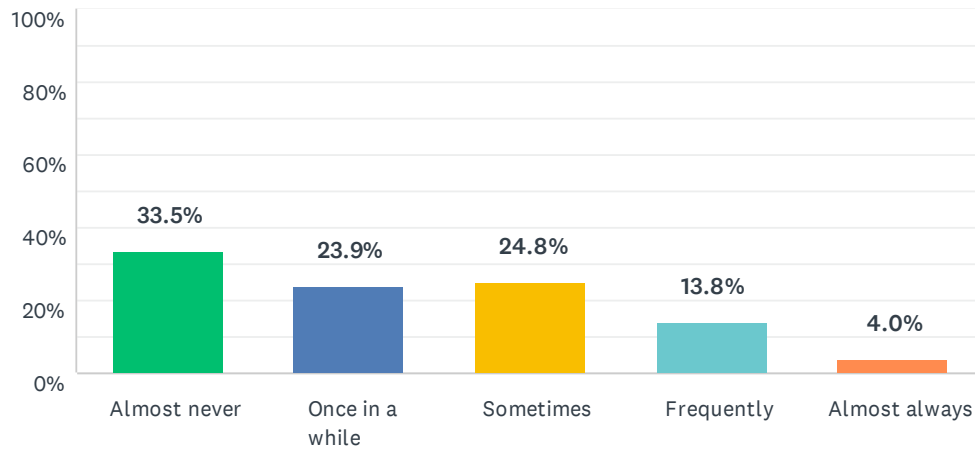

Q34 On average, how often do you think your student talked with classmates regarding schoolwork?

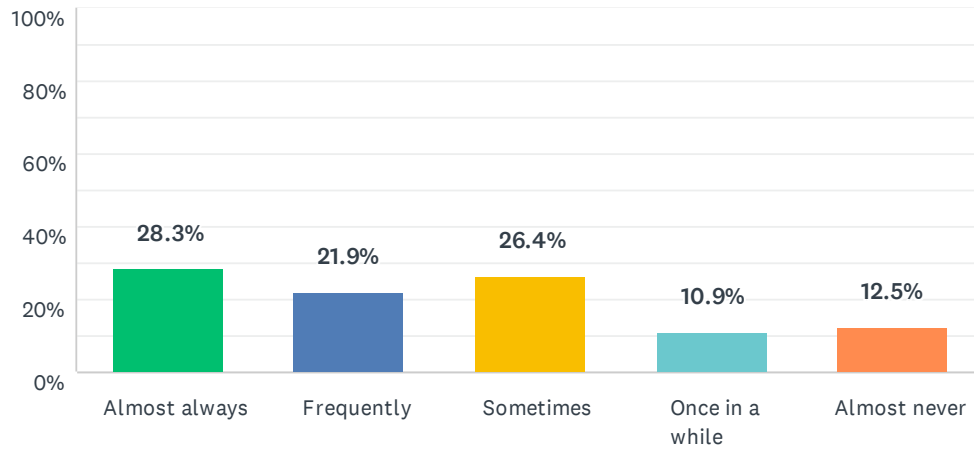

Q35 How motivated was your student to attend classes this year?

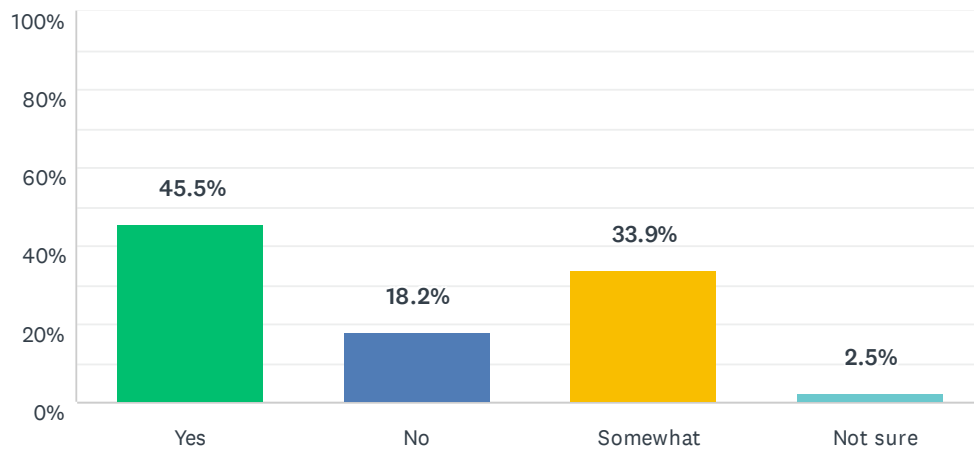

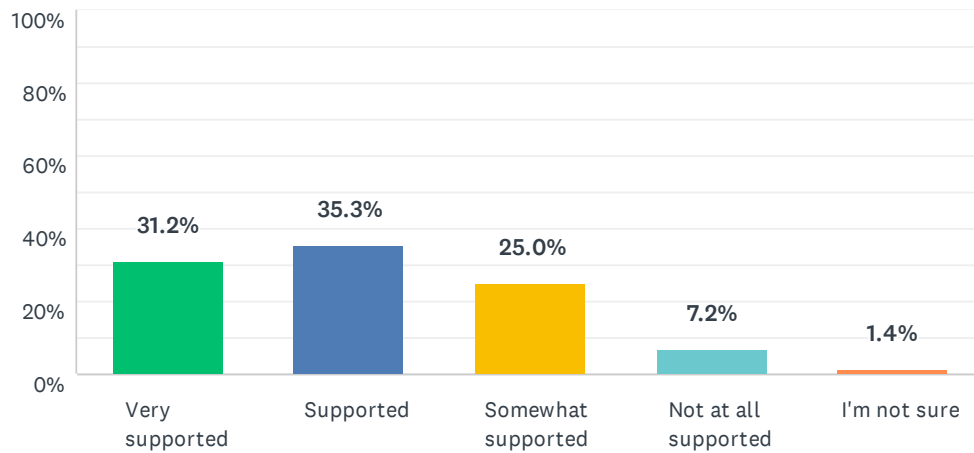

Q40 As a family, how supported do you feel by your student's school?

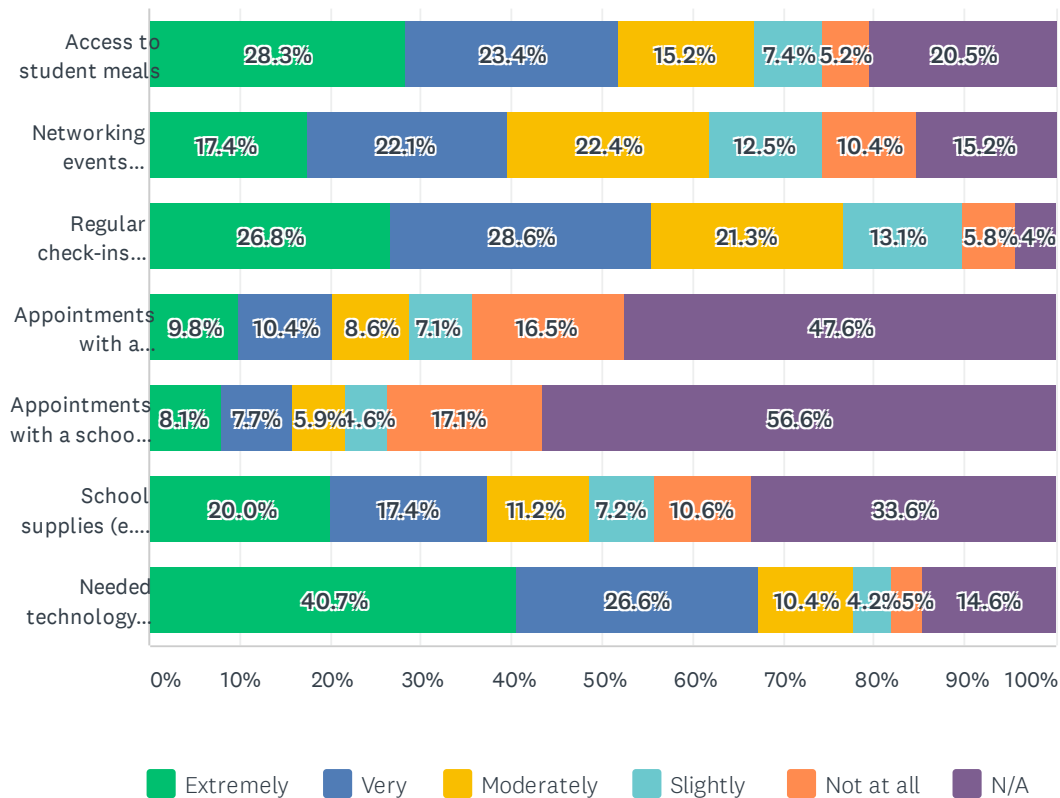

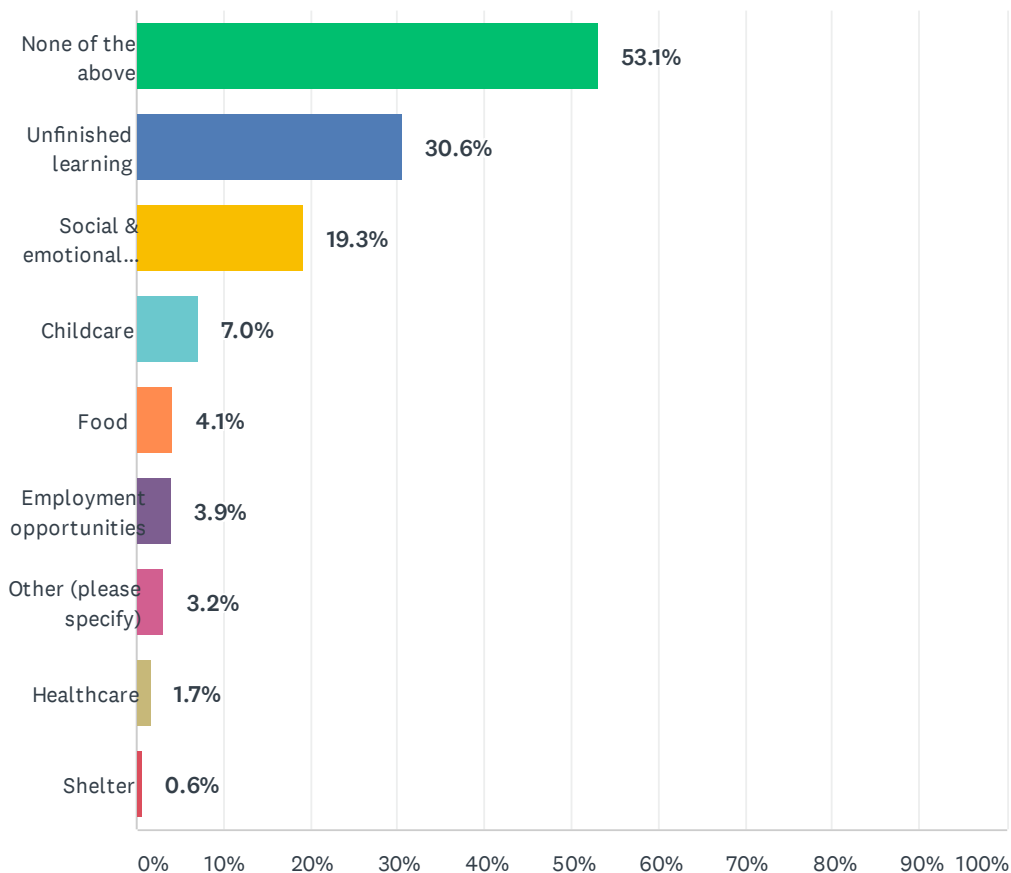

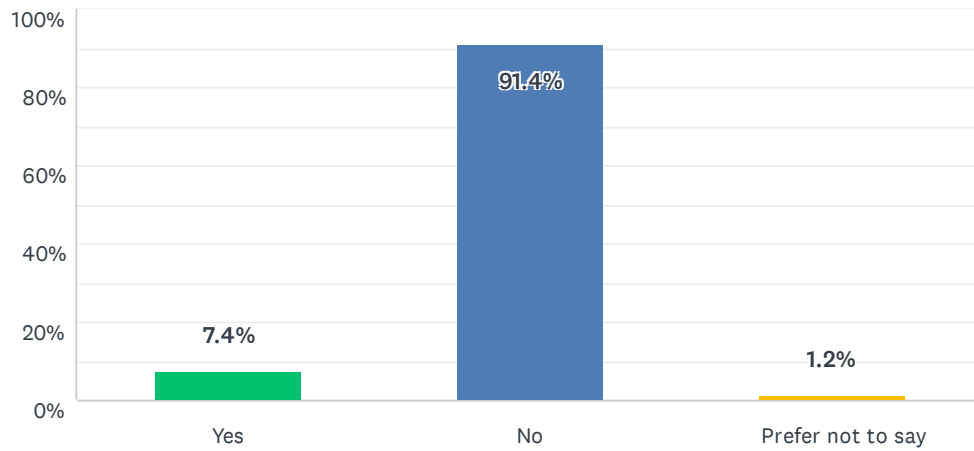

Q44 Does your student currently attend a community organization/childcare before, during, or after school hours?

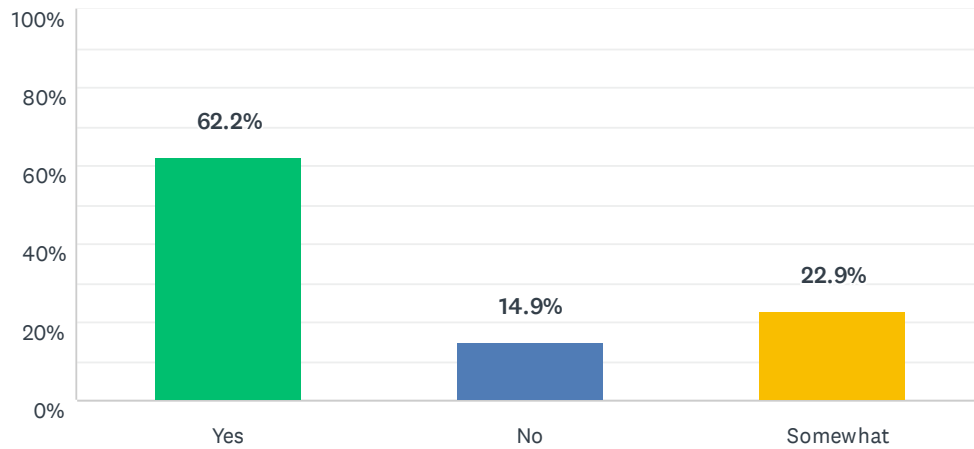

Q46 Has your student's school communicated to you how to get help with in-person/hybrid/remote learning?

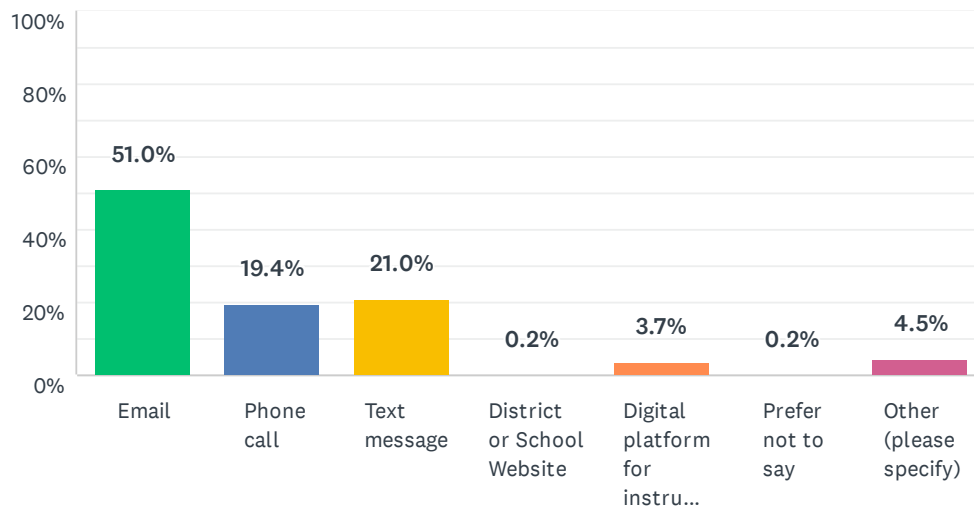

Q47 If your student's teacher needs to reach you, what is the easiest way to stay in touch?

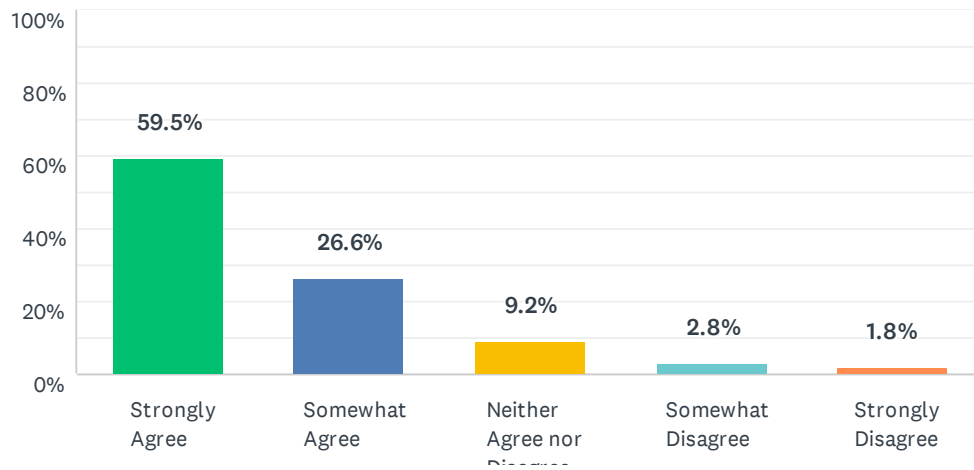

Q48 My district/charter uses methods of communication I prefer:

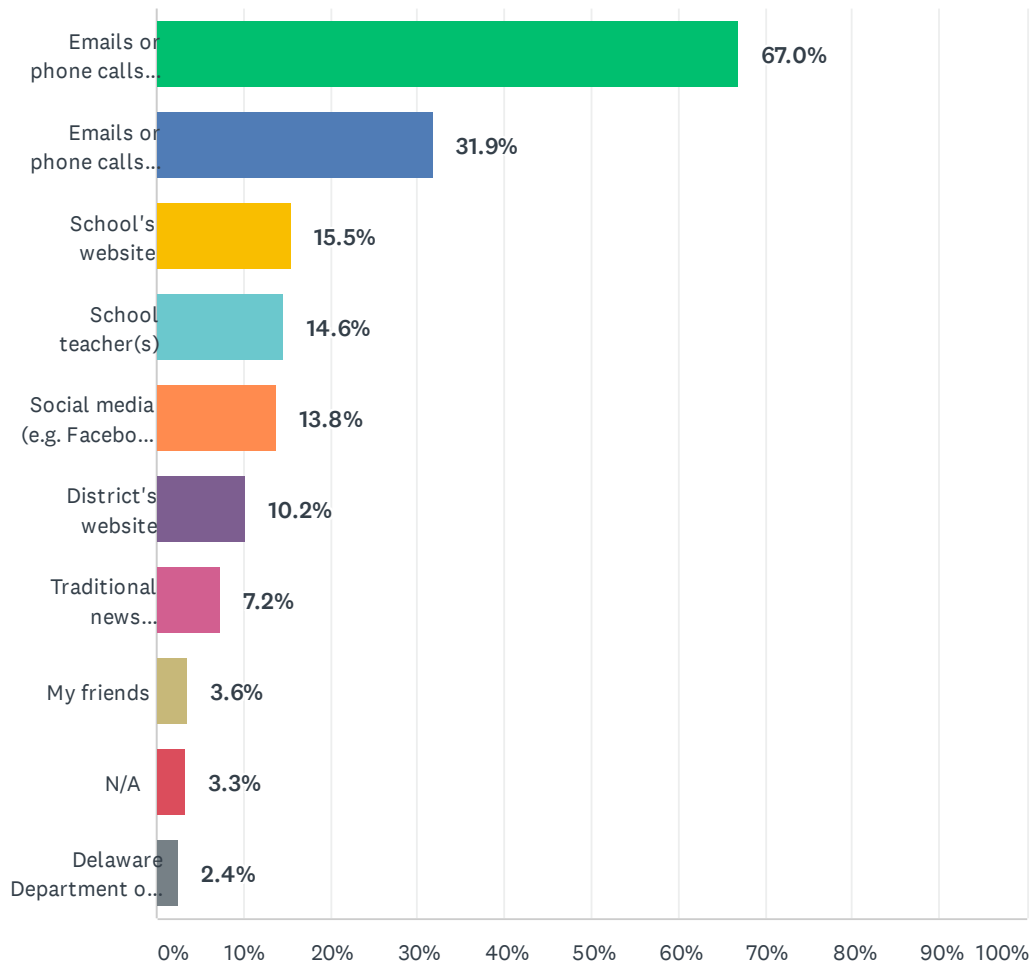

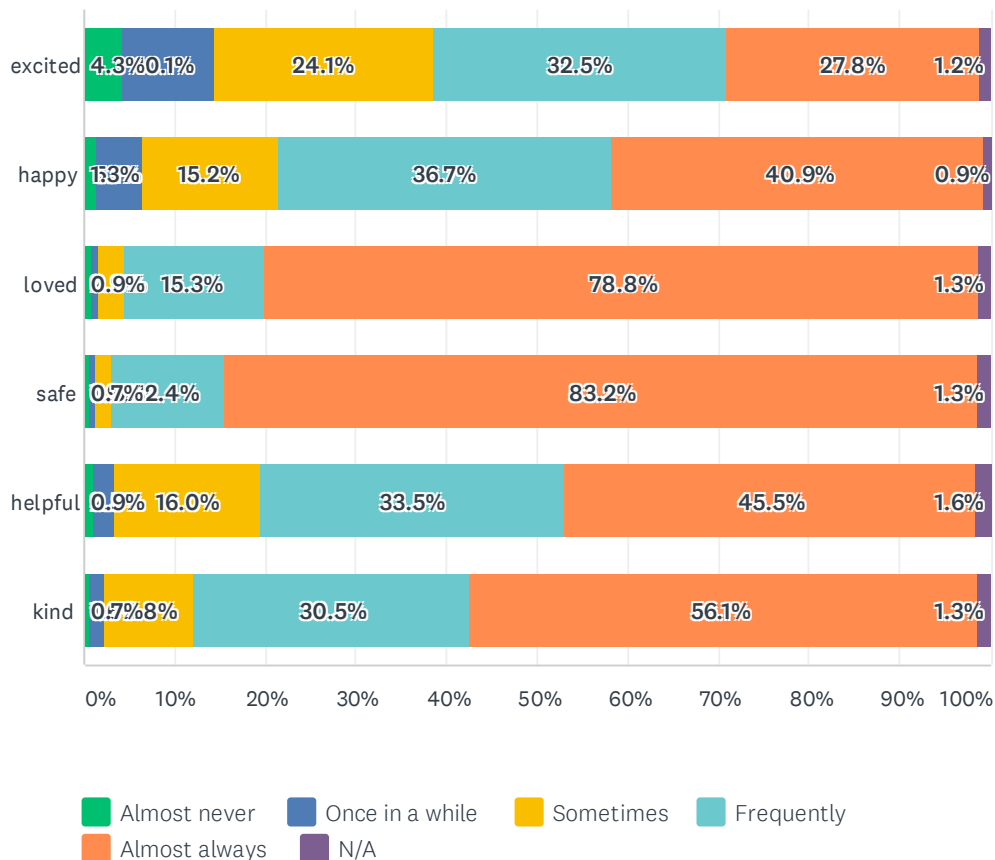

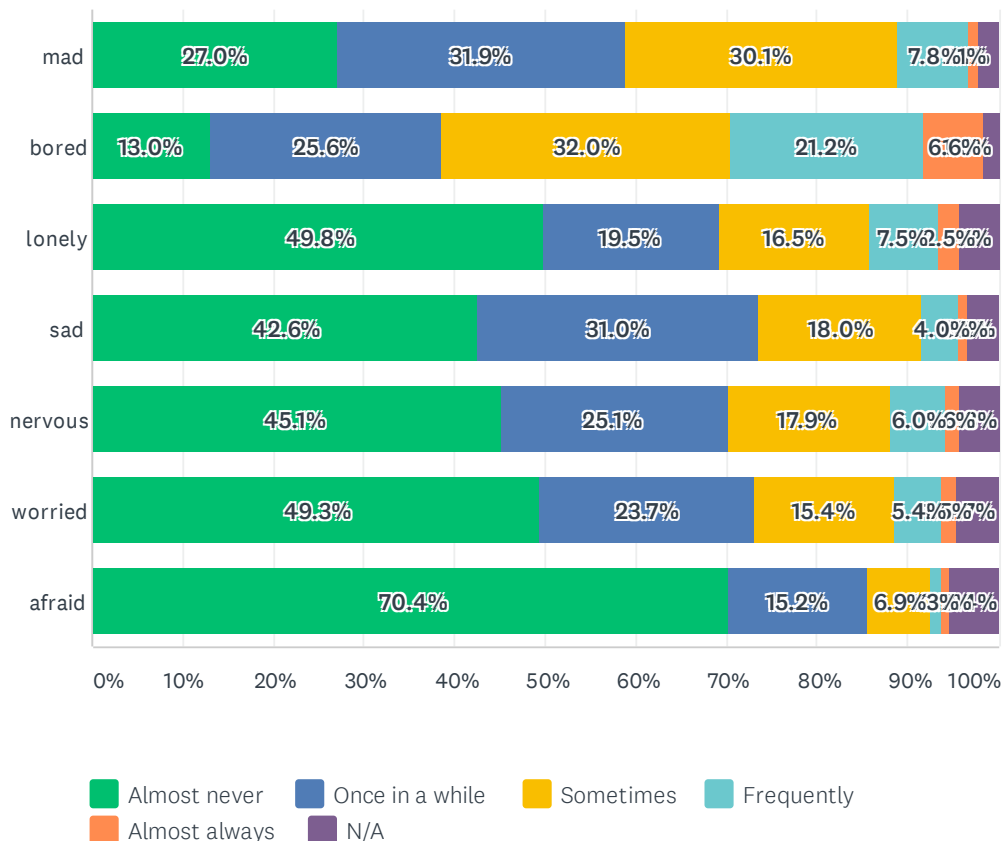

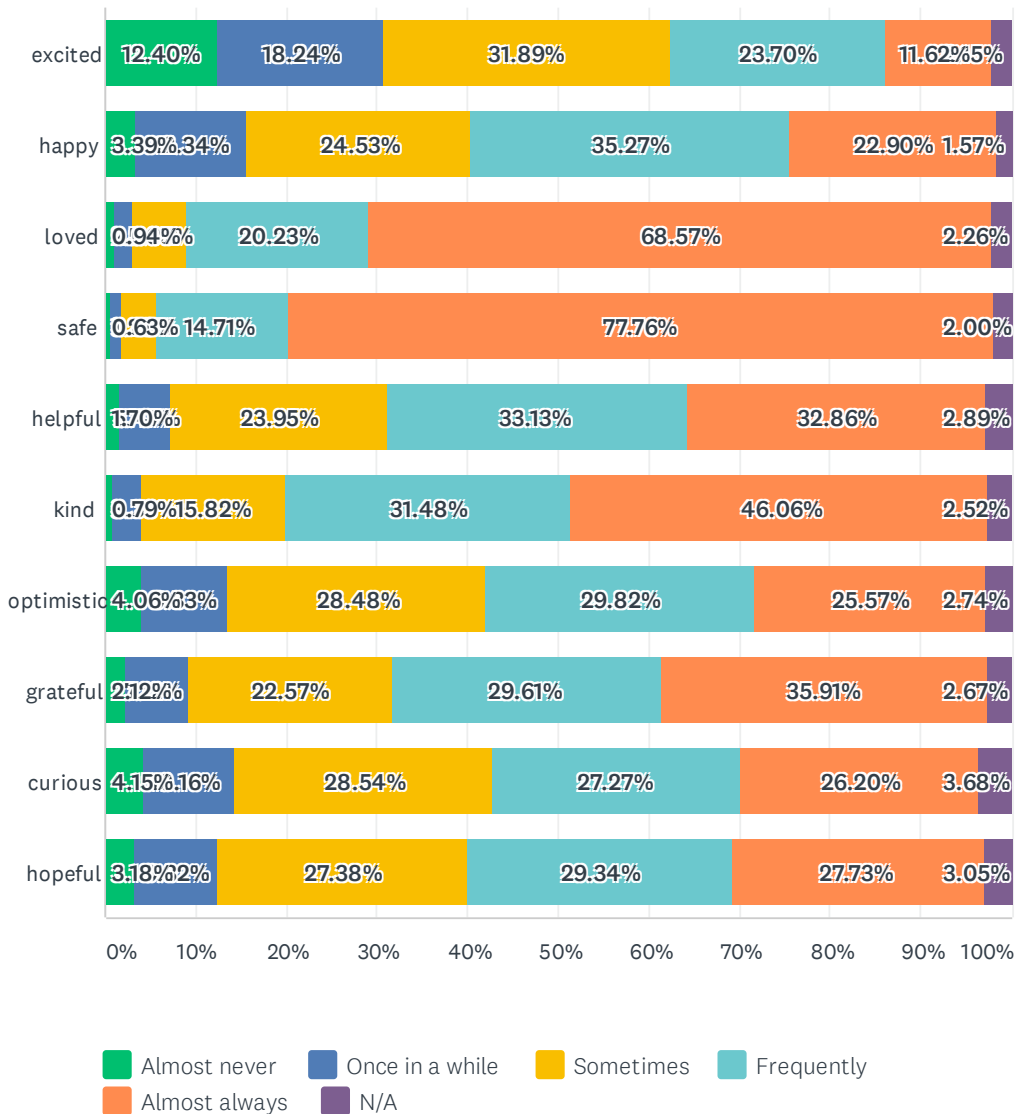
