# Coordinated Early Intervening Services (CEIS) Process




#### **Voluntary CEIS**

LEA's can voluntarily provide CEIS services to students in <u>Kindergarten through Grade 12</u>, who <u>are not currently identified</u> as needing special education services, but who may need additional academic or behavioral supports to succeed in a general education environment.

### Implementing CEIS

The LEA will identify the activities that they will carry out in implementing CEIS on their Consolidated Grant. Professional Development for staff to deliver scientifically-based academic instruction or providing educational and behavioral services, and supports are some examples of appropriate use of CEIS funds.





## <u>Up to 15%</u> of IDEA Funds set aside & reporting requirements

The LEA <u>may use up to</u> 15% of its IDEA 611 & 619 funds, in combination with other funds, to develop and implement CEIS. The state must ensure the LEA meets the reporting requirements regarding the number of students receiving CEIS during the subsequent two-year period. LEA's who choose to use funds voluntarily for CEIS must do so with caution as it may reduce the LEA's ability to meet MOE.
