6. Lunch/Breakfast. Describe the plan for providing meals to students, including ...

LTA intends to participate in the National School Breakfast/Lunch Program, and will contract for meals from a national school breakfast/lunch program vendor which serves healthy food choices. Eighty percent of the meals will be prepared and served on site to all students including those eligible for free-reduced lunches five days a week each week. LTA plans to participate in the Nemours Health and Prevention Services 5-2-1 Almost None Program. LTA plans to grow fresh vegetables in its green garden project. This will offer fresh produce for students and the community to take home for a systemic healthy food choice program.

Eligibility – During the first week of school and in accordance with established state and federal procedures, the school will determine student eligibility for free/reduced meals and students who are homeless. Eligibility will be determined annually during the first week of school and in accordance with established stated and federal procedures. The CEO and school leader will work with the food service vendor to ensure that all means are consistent with state and federal guidelines and compliant with USDA regulations. *See Appendix 1 Section 1.8 Nemours 5-2-1 Almost None Formula for Healthy Living.*
