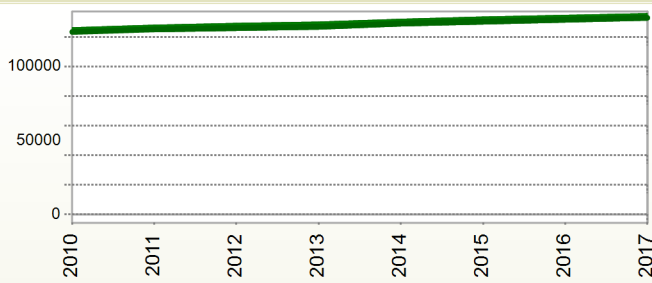

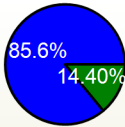

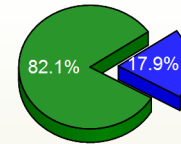

**Instructional vs. Support (2016-2017)**



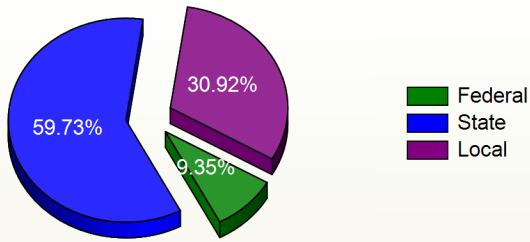

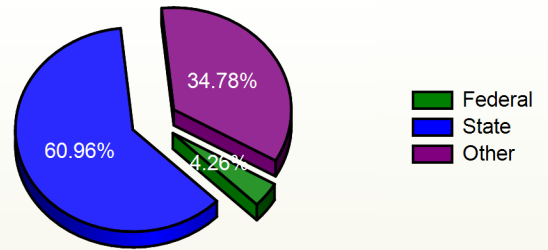

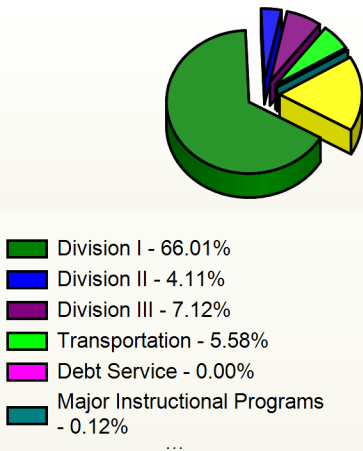
State Source of Educational Revenue (2015-2016)



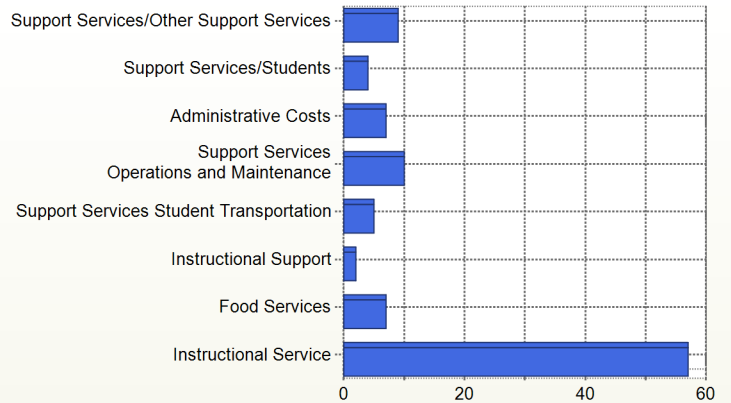
Charter Schools Source of Educational Revenue (2015-2016)
