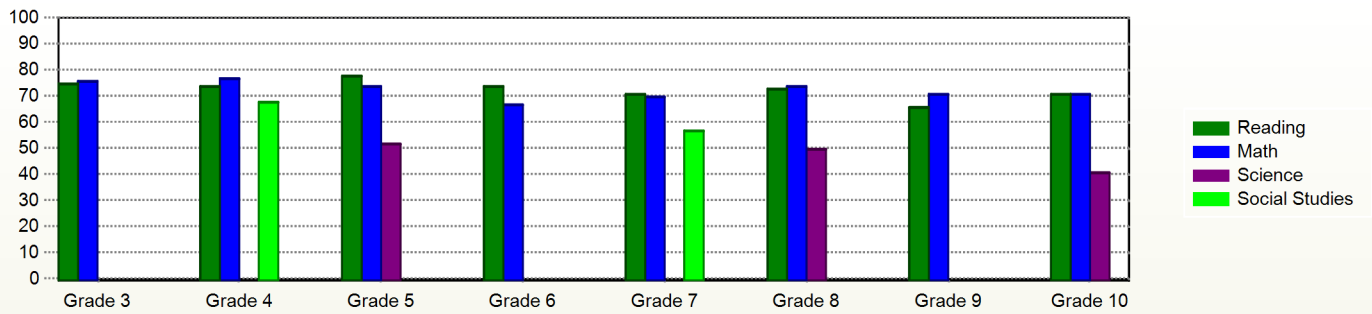

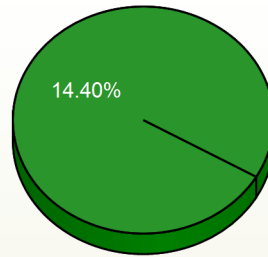

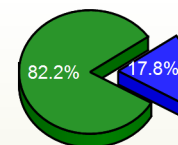

Instructional Vs Support



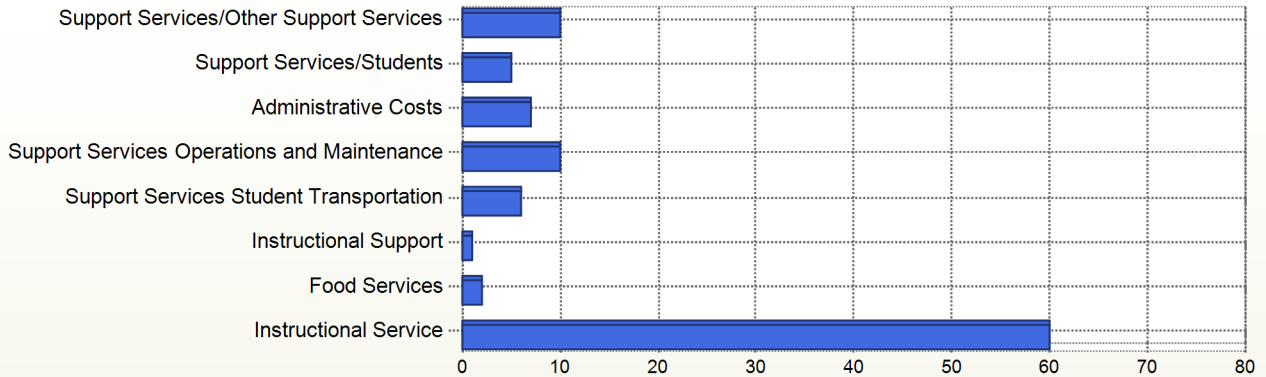

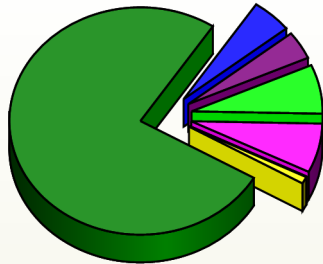

Percent District Allocation of Current Expenses by Category

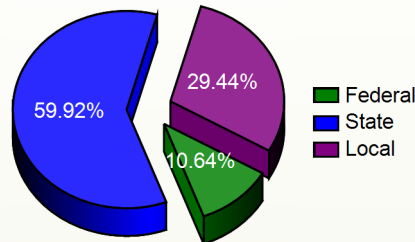


Revenue Receipts - State Appropriations

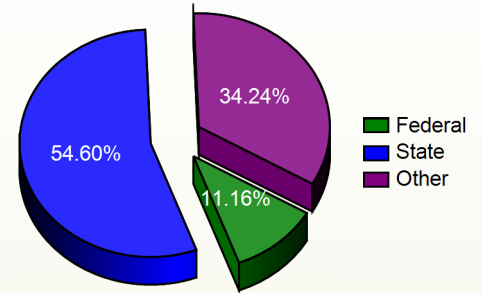
