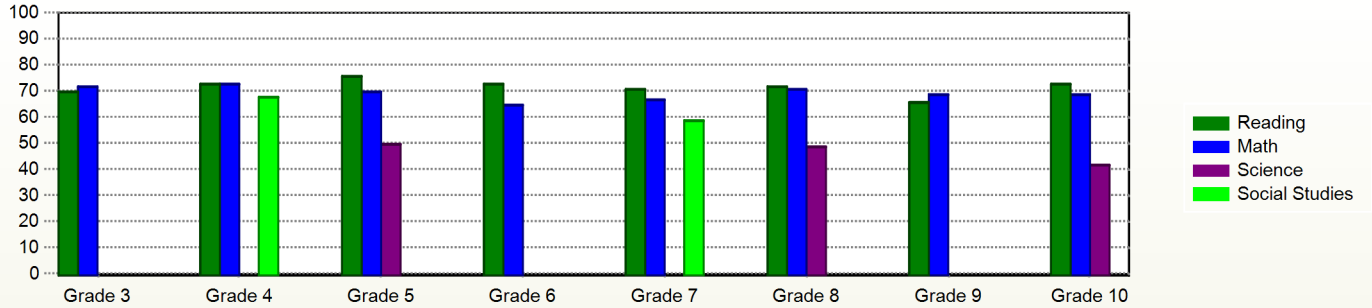

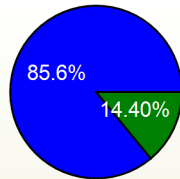

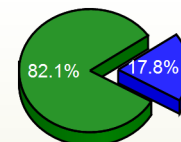

Instructional vs. Support (2012-2013)



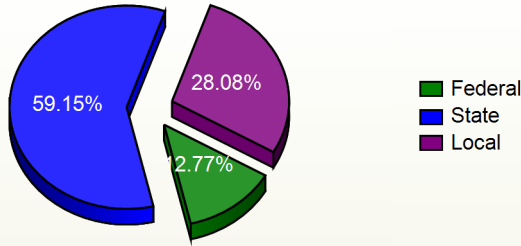

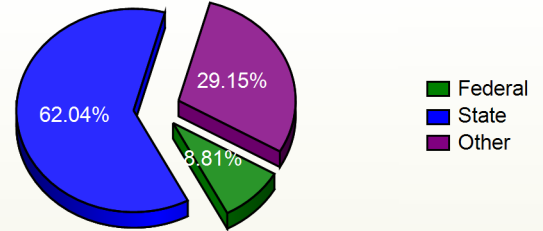

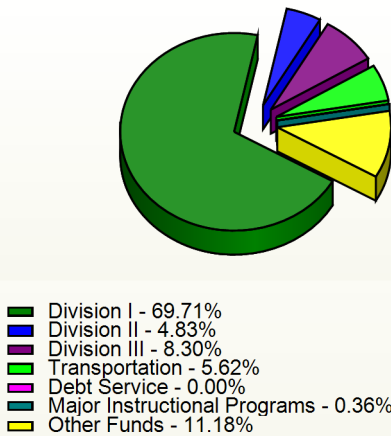
State Source of Educational Revenue (2011-2012)



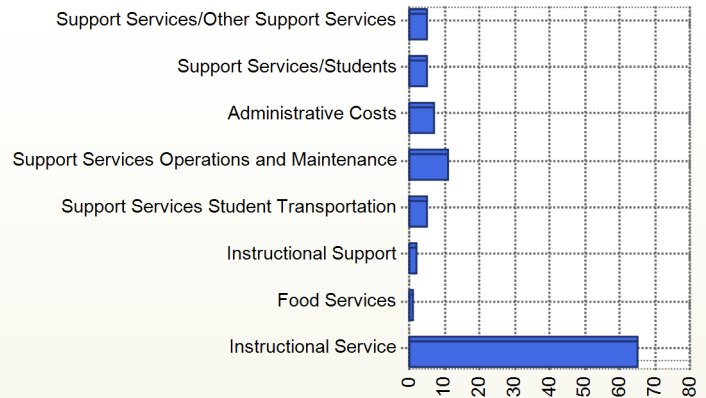
Charter Schools Source of Educational Revenue (2011-2012)
