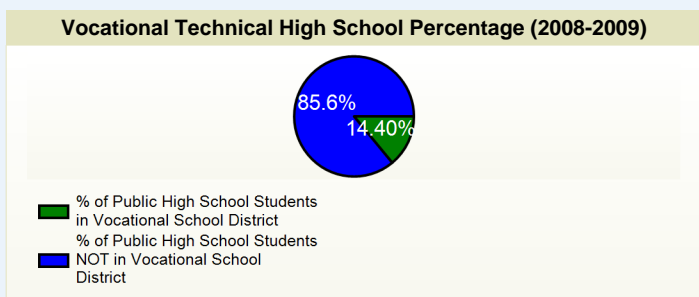

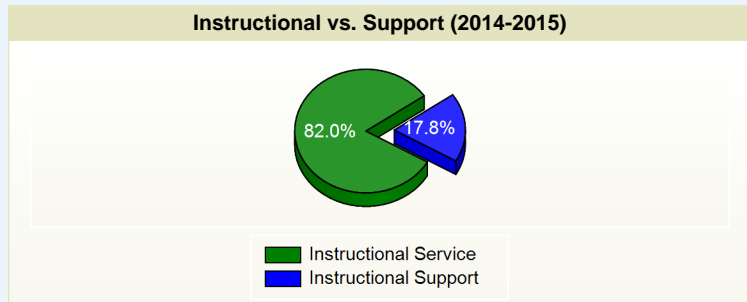

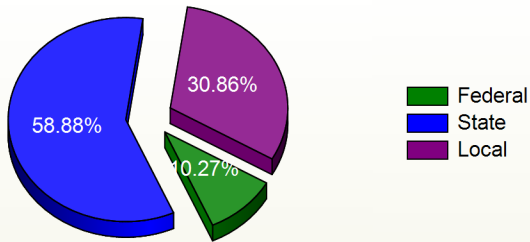


State Average Teachers Salary (2014-2015)

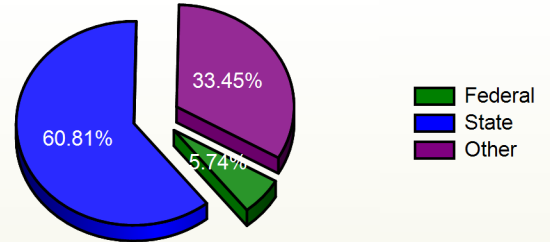

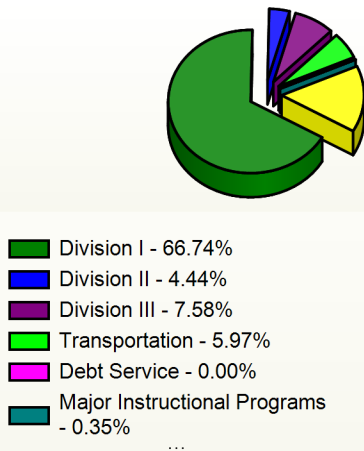
State Source of Educational Revenue (2013-2014)



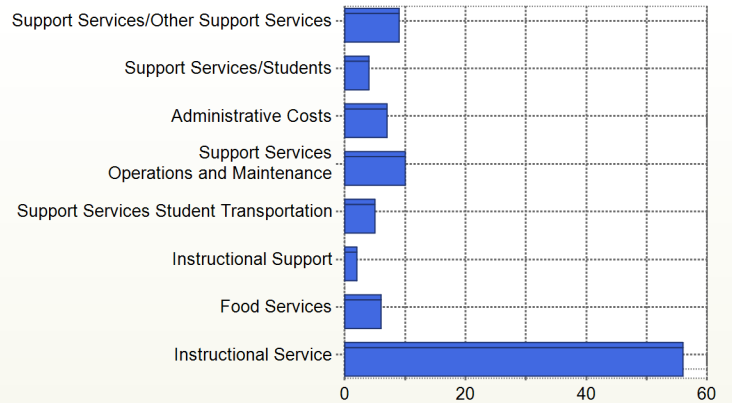
Charter Schools Source of Educational Revenue (2013-2014)
