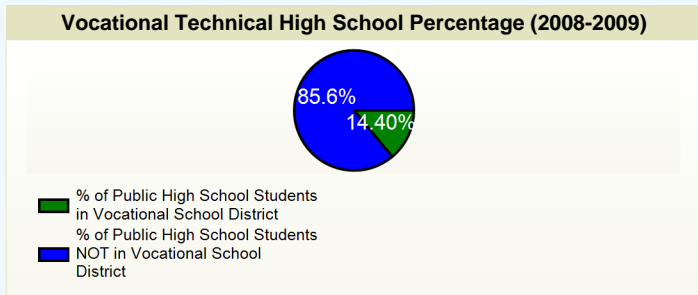

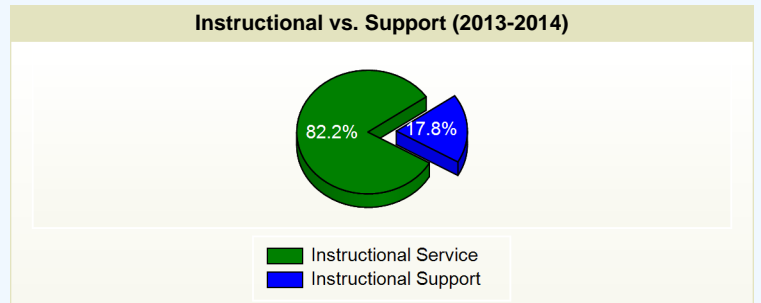

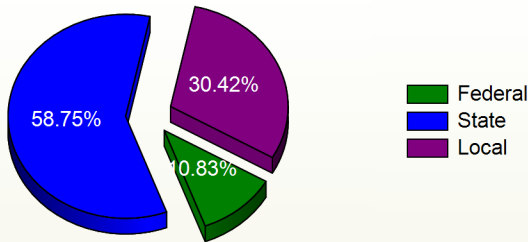


State Average Teachers Salary (2013-2014)

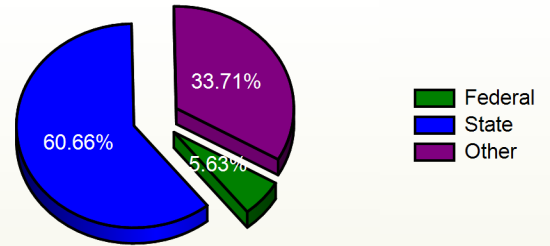

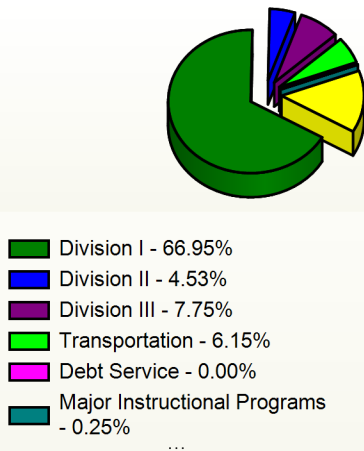
State Source of Educational Revenue (2012-2013)



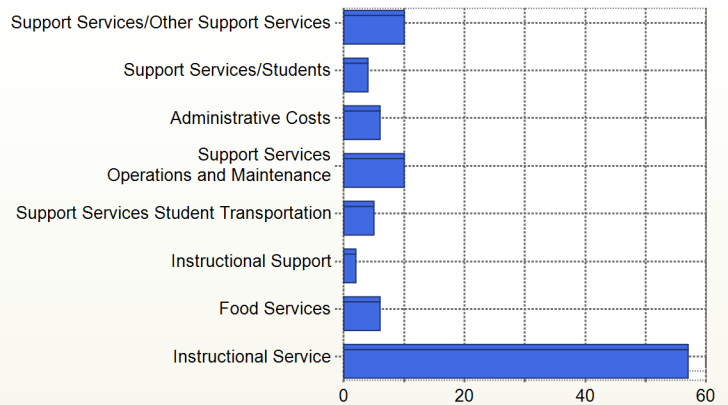
Charter Schools Source of Educational Revenue (2012-2013)
