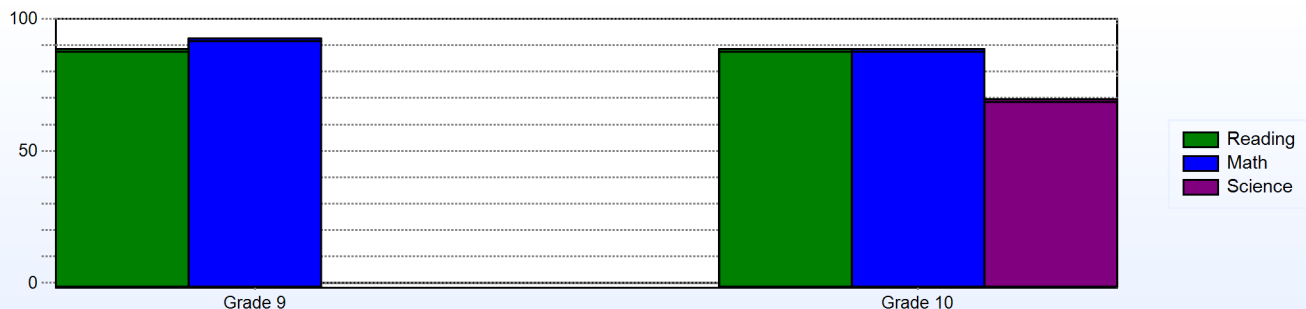

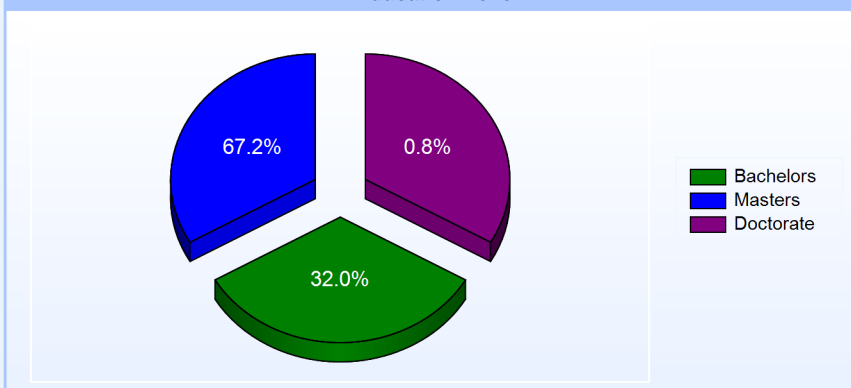

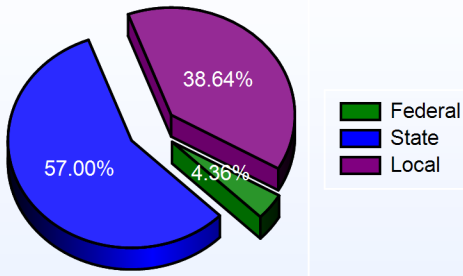

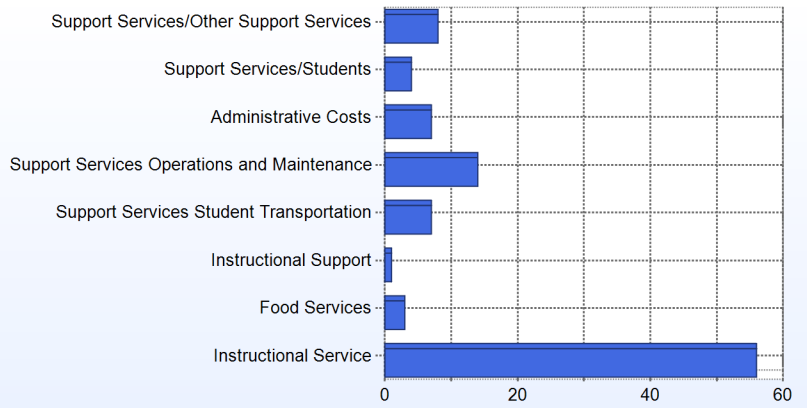

Percent District Allocation of Current Expenses by Category

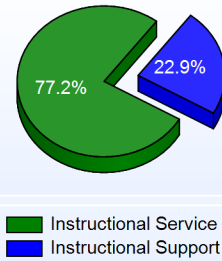

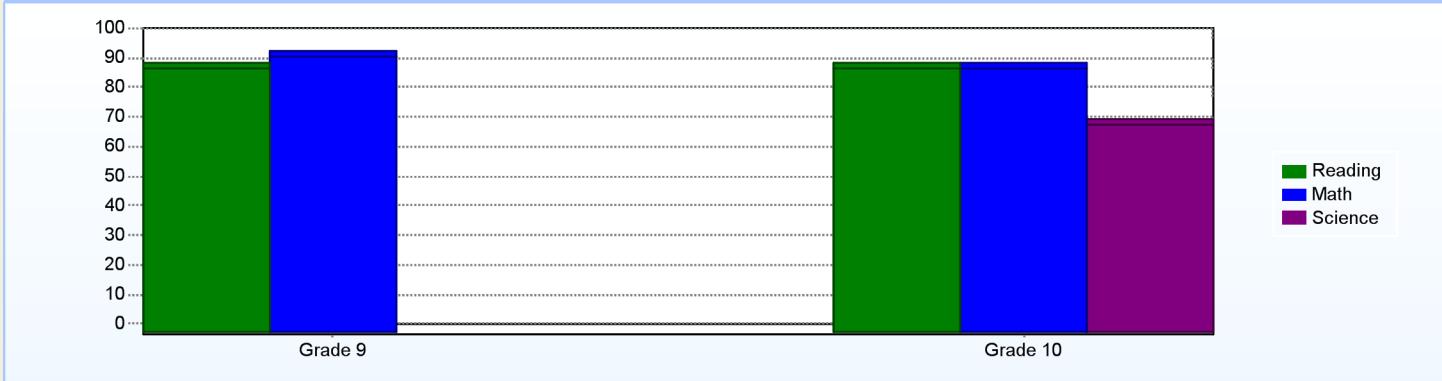

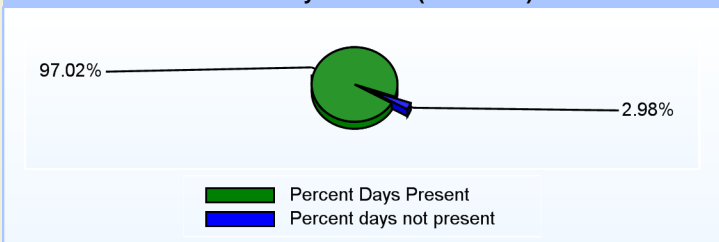

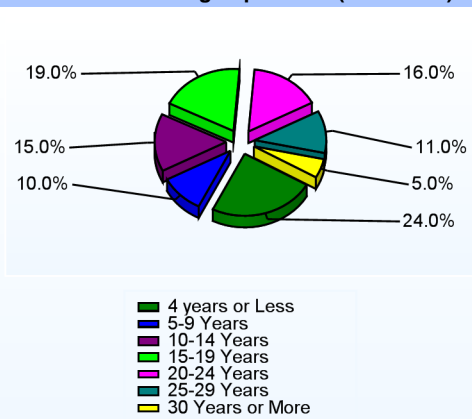

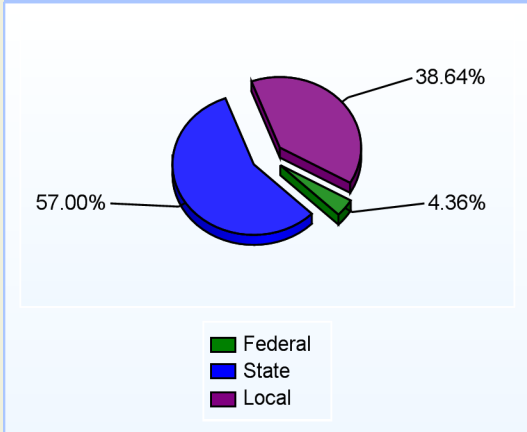

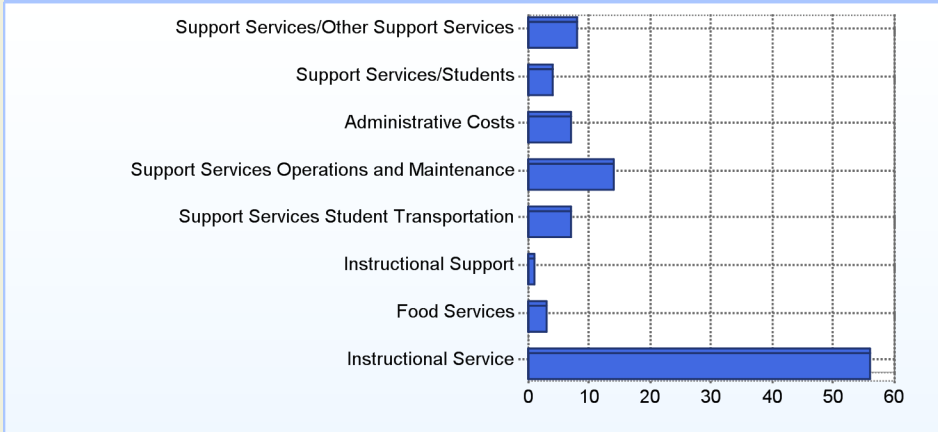

Percent District Allocation of Current Expenses by Category (2012-2013)

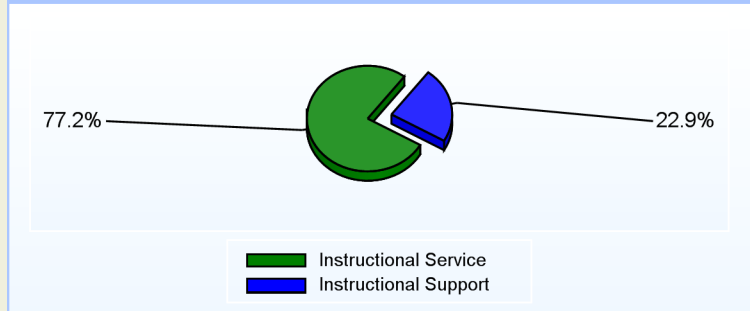
