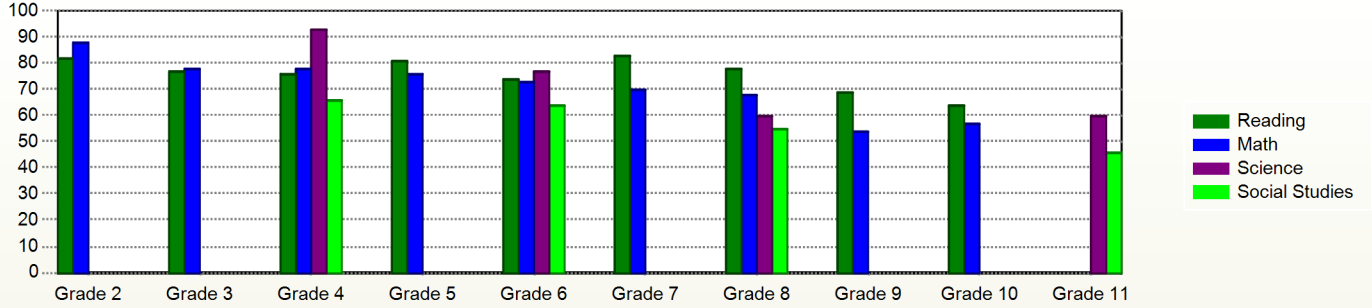

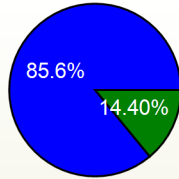

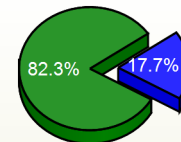

Instructional vs. Support (2010-2011)



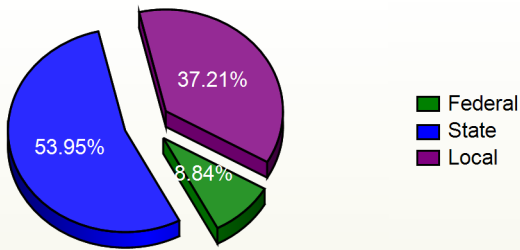

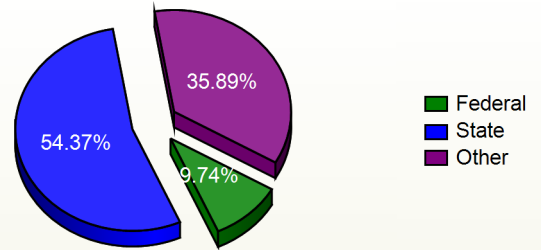

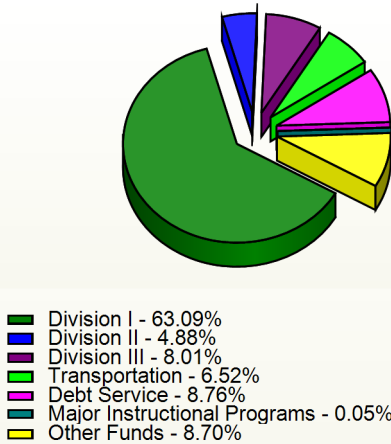
State Source of Educational Revenue (2009-2010)



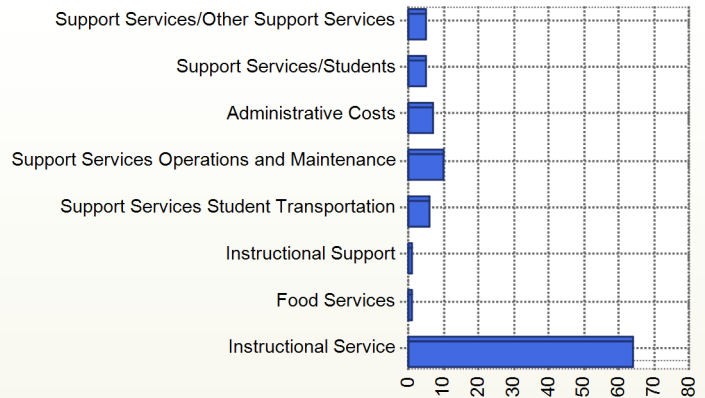
Charter Schools Source of Educational Revenue (2009-2010)
