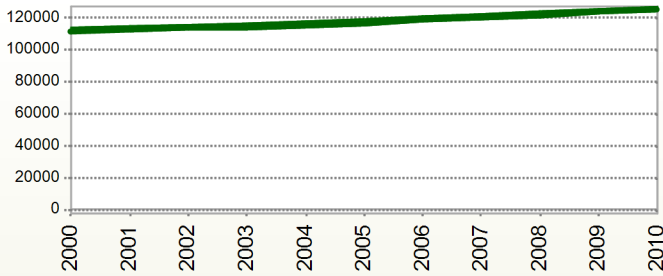

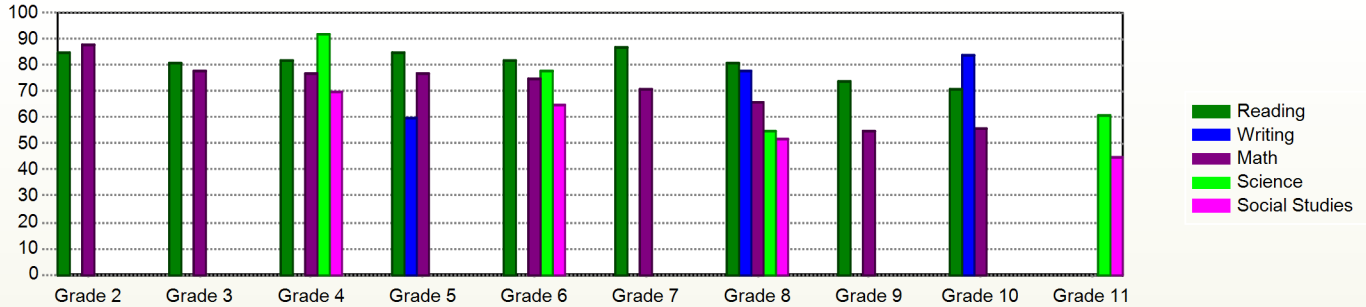

Percentage of Students Meeting State Standards (2008-2009)



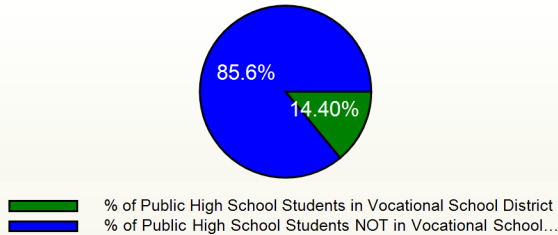

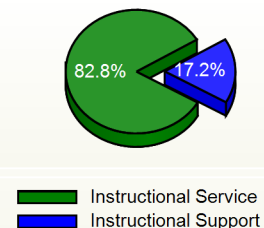

Instructional vs. Support (2009-2010)

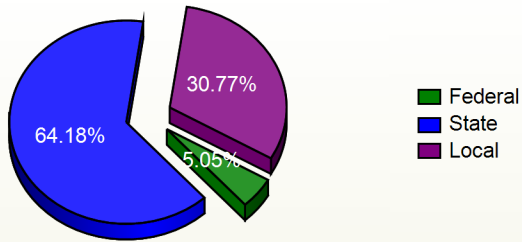

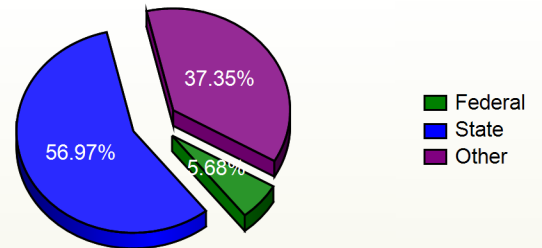

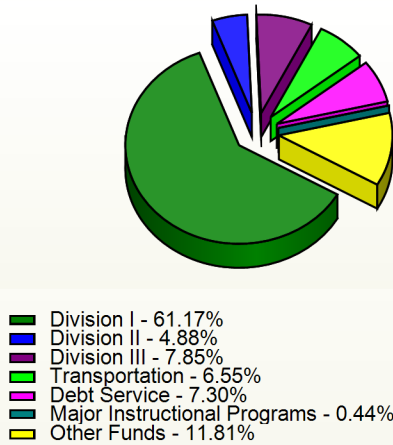
State Source of Educational Revenue (2008-2009)



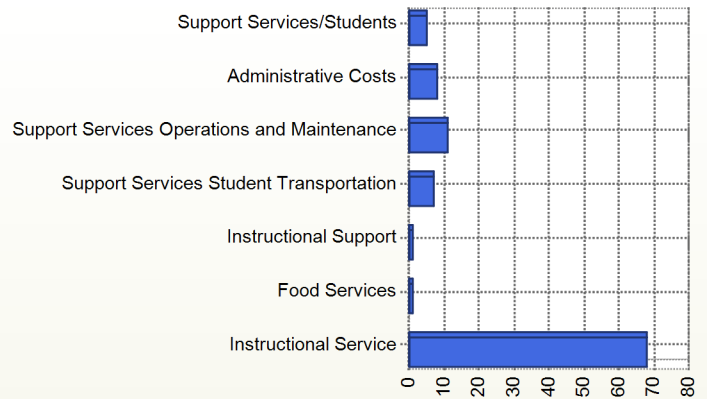
Charter Schools Source of Educational Revenue (2008-2009)
