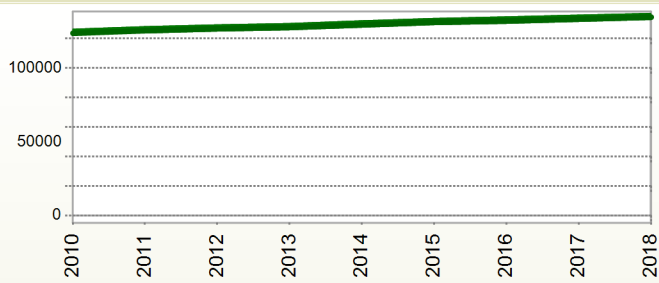

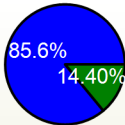

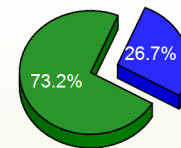

**Instructional vs. Support (2017-2018)**



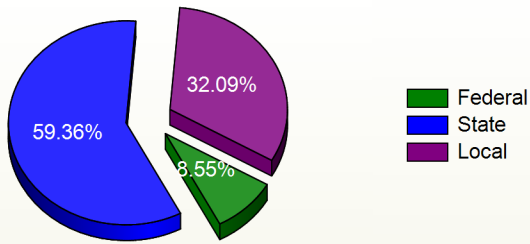

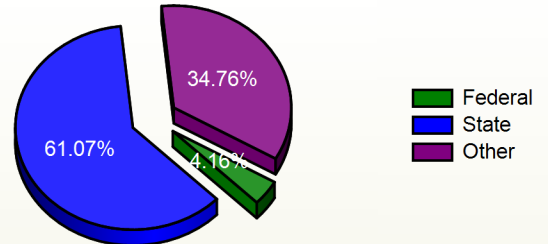

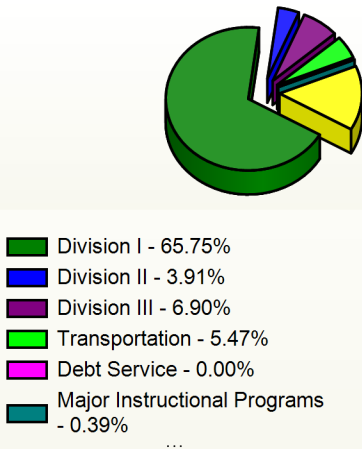
State Source of Educational Revenue (2016-2017)



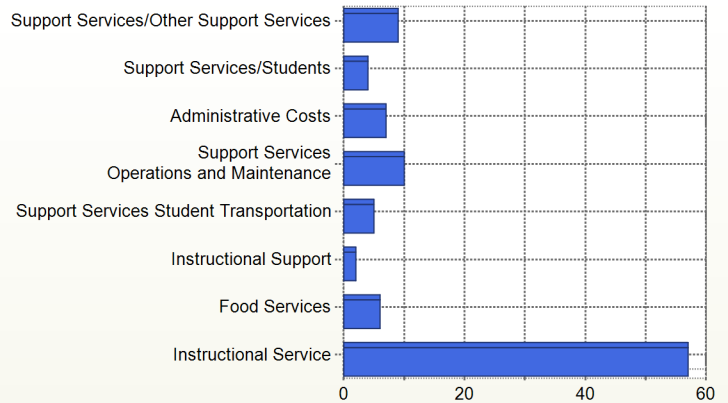
Charter Schools Source of Educational Revenue (2016-2017)
