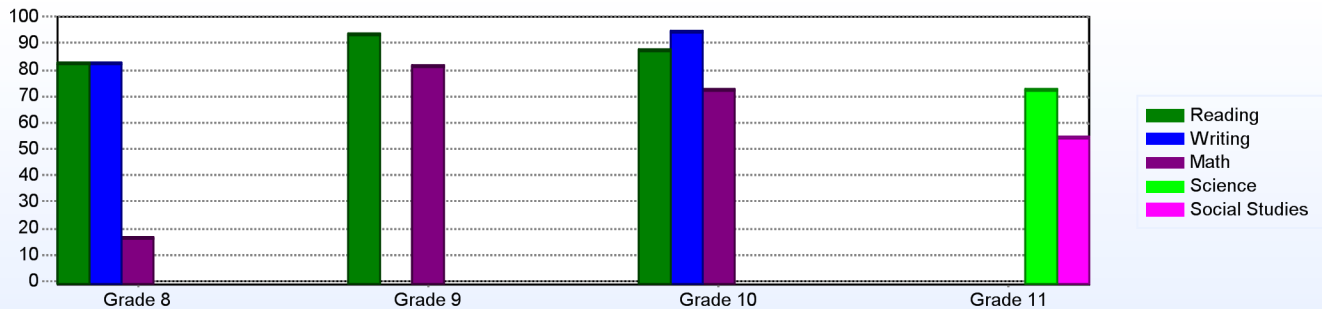

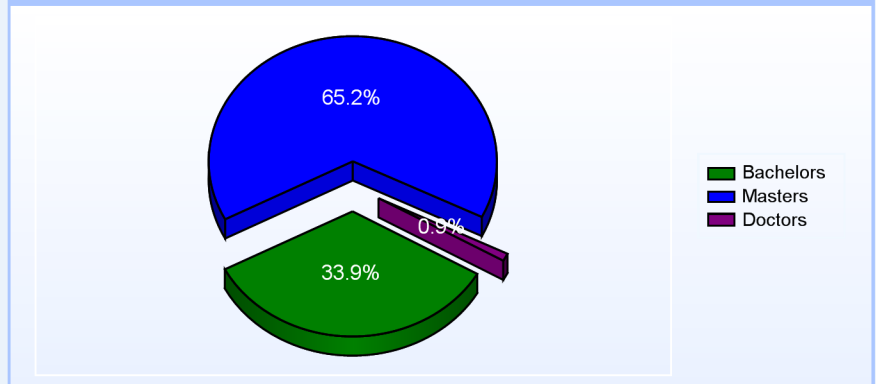

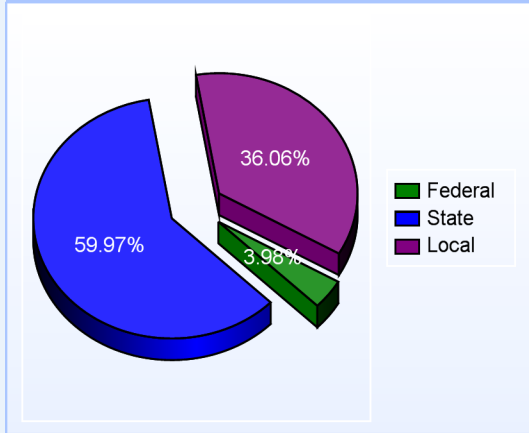

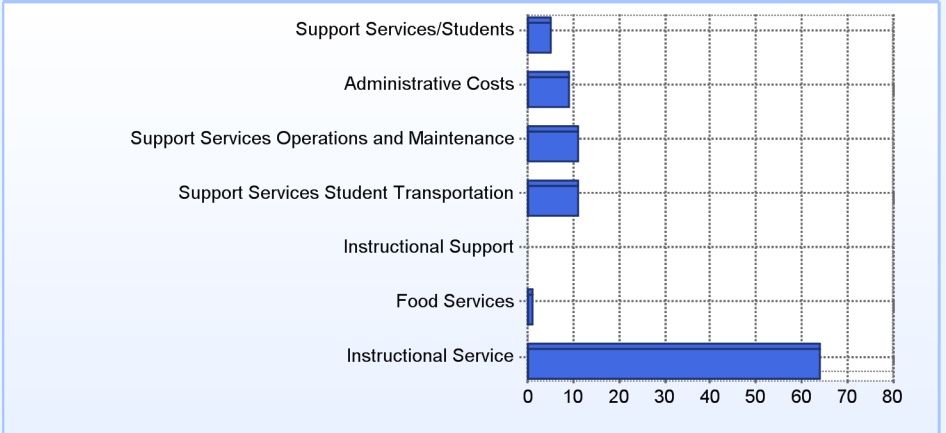

**Percent District Allocation of Current Expenses by Category**

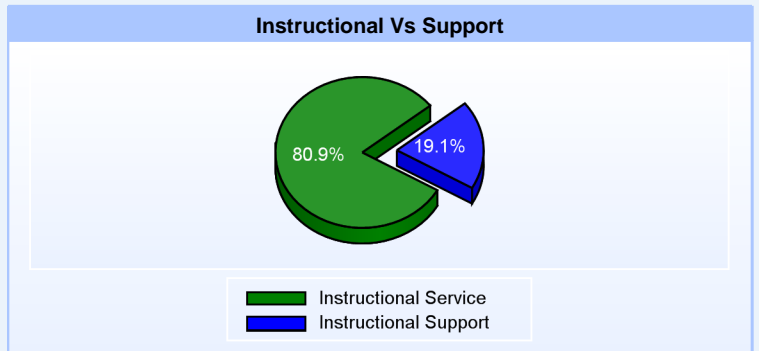

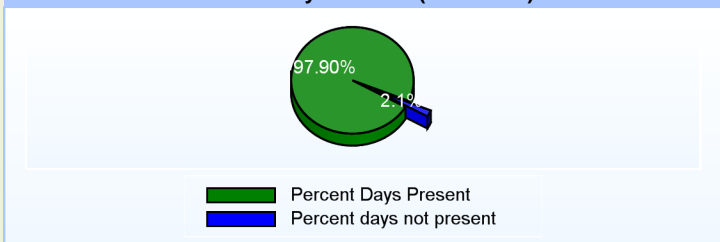

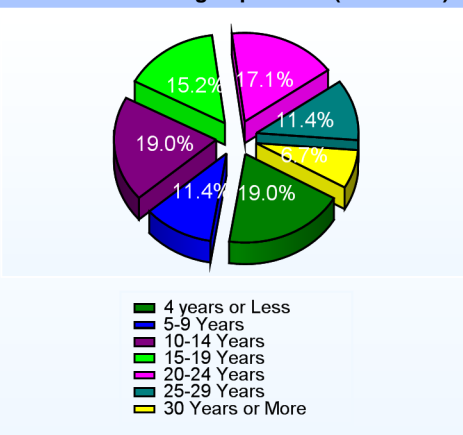

**Curriculum Highlights**

Learning is motivated by using the students' interest in the technical career path of their choice. Students complete a structured program of study, a sequence of academic and technical courses that prepare them for employment and post-secondary opportunities. Educational technology is used to prepare students for productive lives after graduation; providing a campus-wide network to connect classrooms to the on-site computers. This provides graduates with an advantage in a competitive workforce. Students are supported in achieving high academic standards. As such, techademic coaching has been established. Students may attend and receive individual tutorials; make up tests and labs; complete projects and homework assignments; use computerized integrated learning systems; and prepare for SAT and PSAT exams. Culminating with a STEM project in their senior year, students prepare a research paper, product in a technical field, and an oral presentation. Students take pride in this project.

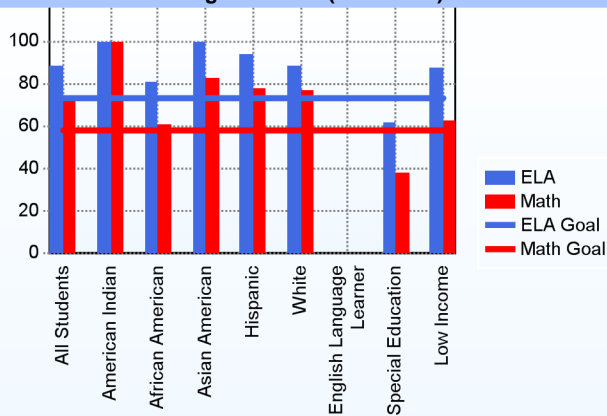

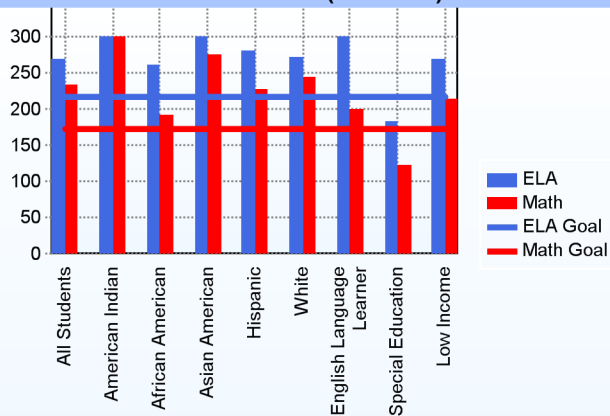

**Growth Model (2008-2009)**



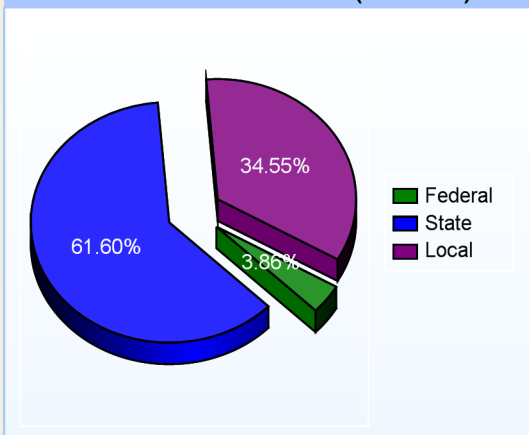

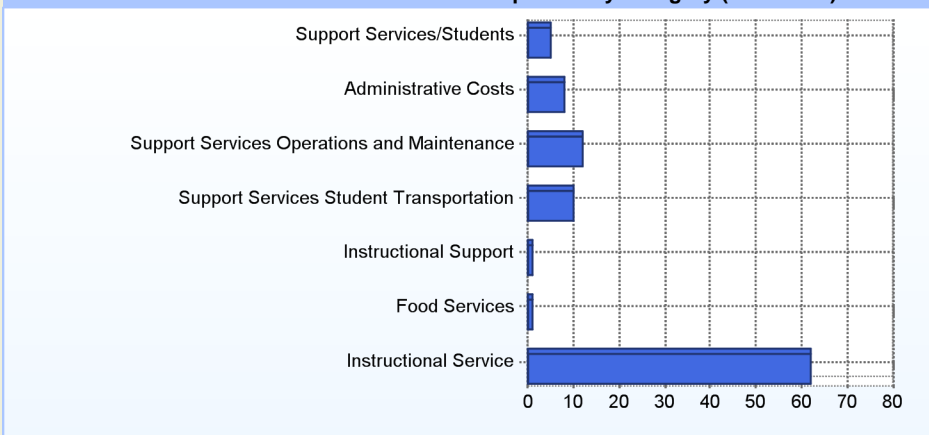

**Percent District Allocation of Current Expenses by Category (2007-2008)**

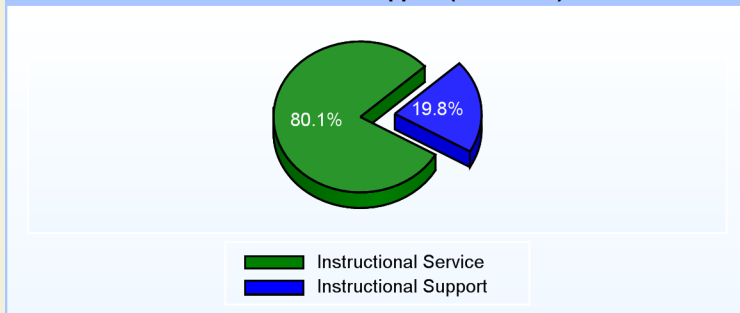
