Activity	Actions	Approximate Time
Initial Session	<p>You will be directed to attend the first session. During this session:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will review all documents for the cycle • You will review the requirements of the cycle • You will be assigned to a learning team • The Lead Mentor will model one session • The Lead Mentor will explain all attendance requirements • The Lead Mentor will explain how all assignments will be collected and returned • The Lead Mentor will explain how to secure the supplemental materials for sessions 	
Learning Team Sessions	<p>Learning teams are made up of no less than three participants.</p> <p>The team will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Determine the dates, times, and locations of meetings • Advise the Lead Mentor of the schedule • Determine who will facilitate each session • Set up group norms 	
Facilitation of a Session	<p>Each team member will be responsible for facilitating at least one session. Teams may choose to nominate co-facilitators. You may elect to facilitate more than one session and count those hours toward your cluster requirements.</p> <p>As you prepare you should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review the chapter, case study or article and construct your session • Seek the assistance of the Lead Mentor for review of your plans • Secure any supplemental materials needed for the session 	
Individual Assignments	<p>There are assignments required of all team members for each session. Members are expected to be prepared and to take an active part in discussions and activities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You are to read the assigned chapter, case study or article for the session. • You will turn in the required assignments to the Lead Mentor as designated. • You are responsible for all assignments and must turn in those from any missed session within two days of the meeting date.
